#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Rogers Communications have a company Evolve come forward to see if they could place a Telecommunications Tower of approximately 30 meters high. Two locations were selected, one on the northeast corner of our parking lot and one inside our fence along the south wall of the building. They approached the City and the one at the upper corner of the parking lot was denied. They have come back to us with the City's agreement if we would agree to put it inside the fence on the south side of the building. It is very similar to the Pattison sign in that it would generate revenue to the branch in our lifetime and further down the road. It would be approximately \$17,000.00 plus per year revenue on a 5 year term and after 5 years Rogers would increase it 10% that would be over a 20 year span. The location inside would be between the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice office and Executive office, and it will appear to be a tall chimney. If we approve this location Evolve can go back to the City and state our approval. They then will go to the neighbors for any objections. I have a color photo of the tower, if you are interested.
