A Talk with the Padre

"LOVE COVERS ALL"

Your Padre's Thoughts, February 2024

Hi there

It is good to be able to communicate with you once again in this new year. I apologize for not submitting a note to you my comrades last month. I could use a myriad of excuses but will only say I was late for the Newsletter.

As I write this on January 16, 2024 it appears as though we have come through a very cold, record-breaking cold temperatures in January, and I am grateful today it almost seems warm compared to what we have experienced. I trust you have been able to stay warm, and I for one am so grateful to live in a warm home, and not have to face displacement and insecure safe accommodations as many of our Edmontonians are forced to.

The thought of February, longer day light hours, and love might well be on the forefront of many of our thoughts. Valentines Day on February 14th. Has at its core the idea of Love, which is in an of itself a "heartwarming idea and notion."

Love comes in many facets and we use that word regularly. As I say at weddings I officiate at, we use words like, "I love my house, I love my dog, I love my car," and the list goes on. Earlier this year my granddaughter who resides in the Ottawa area called and asked if I would officiate their wedding this coming summer. Of course, I would, but what was really exciting was the thrill in her voice as she expressed the love she had for her fiancée' Thomas. Young love, touchy, feely, exciting, it was fun listening to her speak. This past year we welcomed a sixth great grandchild into our family, and it was so much fun to experience the tender love that mom and dad have for their little girl Riley.

Many of us have been blessed with many years of a deep love for our partners, significant other, and we have come to appreciate the security of that deep tested kind of love. For too many of our community who have lost a loved one in this past year, you will know the pain of no longer having that loved one waking up next to us. It seems too often that we find how much we love another person, only after they are no longer with us. For those who this, it is much more than just touch feely kind of love. It is a deep sense of knowing we belong, and we are appreciated for who we are in the relationship we share.

A Talk with the Padre

There is another kind of love however that goes beyond anything we have experienced with another human being. We know that our earthly loved ones sometimes do not measure up, and the same could be said for us. But this other kind of love I am talking about goes way beyond our human understanding of love. We call it "agape" love. The Bible tells us:

John 15:13, "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends."

Jesus spoke those words to His followers, not long before He would offer His life as a sacrifice for their sins, as well as ours, by allowing Himself to be crucified on a Roman Cross, and thereby giving His life for us. That was Love in its purist and loving form.

John 3:16, "For this is how God loved the world: He gave His one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."

Our love for one another is conditional and transitional, "you love me and I will love you." Our love for one another is often given and withdrawn, depending on the circumstances and how I feel about that person at the moment. God's love stands apart from our idea of love. God's love is not tethered to the ups and downs of my circumstances, nor it is based on actions. God's love for us does not waver with our feelings, nor does it hinge on our performance. God's love is constant, it is ever present, not distant, nor is it indifferent, but it is faithful.

1 John 4:16,

"God is love, and all who live in God live in Love, and God's love lives in them."

These next Bible passages are some of my favourites, and have helped me through difficult circumstances and experiences, and I leave them with you to ponder and allow them to guide our thoughts and minds. God's Love is not fickle, and it is something we can cling onto to.

Romans 8:31-38

What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else? Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord. No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.

So, until next time show some love to those we love and who love us in return.






