



A note from your Padre, April/May 2023

As I regularly do in commencing my articles for the Newsletter, is to say thank you to all of you who have served, and or who are currently serving, both in our Military and any of the many First Responder Positions. Your service is so needed and often unappreciated. Please accept my sincere appreciation for all you do, the sacrifice both of your time, resources, time you could spend with family, and for the ultimate price many have paid, both in the distant past and the recent past. Thank you.

This article may turn out to be rather lengthy and so, I will develop it into a two-part series for your reading enjoyment.

I begin by asking the question, "How did the story of a man who taught and practiced unconditional love, peace, and kindness; who spent His life defending the poor and the marginalized; a Man who even forgave His executioners, while they executed Him unjustly, whose life inspired a radical movement that is still impacting the world thousands of years later, how did this Man's story become associated with hatred and the oppression for so many people?

Jesus who created a "Love Movement," that is till inspiring many people today, and despite our political differences, despite our ideological origins, despite all the things that divide us, we are still able to have a beautiful kinship and relationship with Him. Jesus who was both fully man, and at the same time fully God sets for us a model of how we can and should live our lives. That Jesus wishes for each of us to have a life closely connected with Him, and He inspires me to have Him as the focus of the way I live my life.

Imagine with me that you have seven Credit Cards in your wallet, and you lose one. What happens? Well to start with you do not call your friends and neighbours and say, "Hey I lost a C.C. but I have six left so no worries. No, we would call anyone and everyone and ask, "did I leave my CC in your store, your restaurant and you would cover every place you'd been at since your last remember seeing it. The point is that when we lose something we obsess about our loss, we become preoccupied with our loss, and that loss becomes the focal point of our lives.

One more illustration, "Ever lose your Cell Phone?" If we did, we look everywhere, and we take no comfort in knowing that we may well have several other electrical gadgets and devices. No, we search until we find it, and our loss becomes our focal point, our preoccupation.

Jesus told a similar story, not about Credit Cards, or Lost cell Phones but about Lost people. God is focused on people who do not yet enjoy a personal relationship with Him, through His Son Jesus. One of the amazing things about Jesus, was that "THAT PEOPLE NOTHING LIKE JESUS, LIKED JESUS. Although many would consider Jesus a religious person, the truth is that H spent very little time with religious people. He was a Righteous person, and yet He spent most of His time with the very unrighteous people. Jesus came from God, but he did not spend a whole lot of time with Godly people. Friends if we were first century people and we would run into Jesus, we would like Him. You may not be part of a church, you may not even like the Church, but you would like Jesus, and He would like you.

A Talk with the Padre

Let's take a look at some stories Jesus told, and these stories explain what is behind His heart, His love and His passion for people who were nothing like Him. People just like you and me. The stories I want to consider are found in the book of Luke, Chapter 15. But first the back story that sets up the story that Jesus is getting to. In Verse 1 of this chapter sets up the three stories.

Verse 1, "now the tax collectors, and "sinners" were all gathering around Him, wow, that is the kind of people Jesus was hanging around with. Tax Collectors were Jewish people who were employed by the hated Roman Government, to collect taxes. Rome determined how much the taxes were, and the tax collectors could collect whatever amount they wanted, just as long as Rome got the amount they assessed. These tax collectors were thieves who stole from their own people. They were the lowest of the low of the then Jewish people. You could not get any lower than they were on the wrung of the ladder. They were betrayers, they had joined forces with Rome and profited from cheating their own people. But these people loved hearing Jesus speak, and often in scripture you found Jesus hanging out with them. The Jewish leaders were not only bewildered but angry that Jesus would hang out with these low-class people. But Jesus tells stories to a very mixed group of people, the tax collectors, and the Jewish leaders. Jesus knows the question that the Jewish leaders are asking, "why would He hang around with the rife raff of society, the low life people?"


Jesus tells three stories, which challenges or at least should challenge us all.

Story #1. Luke 15:3-7

Then Jesus told them this parable: "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

The Jewish leaders were listening intently, and they would agree. If any of them lost a sheep, that would be their focus. They would leave the 99 that were safe and go out and search of the one that was lost. They would not say, "hey I've still got 99 left so leave the lost one out there. No, they would go and search of that one lost sheep. And, when they found it, they would call their friends over and celebrate, saying "rejoice with me, I have found my lost sheep. The point is that when we lose something of value, we focus on what is lost, even at the exclusion of what is secure.
