Greetings fellow Comrades. My name is Brett Finch & this is my inaugural year of being the Kingsway Branch Chairman for the annual Poppy Campaign. There is a core of very experienced volunteers who have been very supportive with assisting the 2023 campaign in early preparations & additionally, many have already slotted in their names to "stand a watch/post/shift" or to take on the role of delivery/passenger driver. With over 300 positions to fill, including our experienced campaign volunteers who are already taking up positions & roles, we are still in great need to fill the many roles & positions. Positions such as Drivers & helpers for business routes, mall sitter or a Driver to basically "Uber" around other volunteers to their positions (where parking is not available). I truly appreciate how hectic personal schedules can be, I am requesting those that can find an opening in their availability to "stand (sit) one watch/post/shift" in a mall position (uniform is encouraged but not required,) or to contribute a day to be a Driver. Filling these 300+ positions from members & friends of the Kingsway Legion Branch is an attainable goal if every member & friend of the Kingsway Legion can contribute some personal time. Prior to my recent retirement, when I was working fulltime & coaching, some years I could volunteer for a daytime role, other years, I was only able to work in a couple night slots in the Northgate mall where I could take the last shift & return the Poppy Campaign kit & cash donations back to the Legion. Perhaps you may be able to find an available time slot that will fit within your personal schedule? Please sign up via the clipboards & volunteer sheets located in the Kingsway Branch lobby for just *one* position or role. 

# Red Shirt Friday History



Military spouses Lisa Miller and Karen Boier organized an event and rallied many of their fellow Canadians to show up wearing red. While the "RED" is the color that fits the acronym, it also happens to work perfectly with the Canadian flag.

# Red Shirt Friday History

These events gathered steam and grew continuously until, eventually, its reach extended all the way up to the Canadian Prime Minister, Stephen Harper. On <u>Sept</u> <u>23rd</u>, <u>2006</u>, Harper led a rally of thousands in a show of solidarity for the Canadian soldiers deployed to Afghanistan as part of the Global War on Terrorism.


RED Fridays seem to wax and wane in terms of popularity among civilians, but the core of the movement is important: to Remember Everyone Deployed. The Global War on Terrorism is now officially older than troops eligible to enlist and serve in that same war — it's important to remember that we've *still* got men and women out there fighting for us.

It's not hard to show your support for the troops: Simply pick something red from your members, and supporters of the troops, but it actually got its start about a dozen years ago. Let's talk about how this patriotic way of showing your support for the troops that are in harm's way got started and why it's an important movement.

It was back in the "old days", when we were still on the "Kingsway" site that a member, Sapper, told me a story of a logo design that he put on a red T-shirt, for the local MFRC to sell to help pay for their programs. They didn't have the resources to do so. I asked him if I could take it on instead. Chuck Isaacs gave me permission, and TNT Promo Products Ltd. kept me supplied with the T-shirts and the merchandise that helped raise thousands of dollars for our local Military Family Resource Centre. Through our Legion, the Exhibition and many other locations in and out of Alberta, we were able to raise these funds. Thank you, Mac, Betty, Wayne, our office staff, and everyone else who volunteered during these events.


