Community Report from MPD Second District

Presentation and Resolution on Renaming Melvin Hazen Trail/Area 630 of Rock Creek Park

The National Park Service (NPS) removed the previous name after reviewing the role of the namesake in discriminatory development policies in the area. NPS has proposed to rename the trail after Ms. Georgia Ellard, the first African American administrative officer in the NPS National Capital Parks office, as well as the first woman superintendent of Rock Creek Park. Ms. Ellard worked her way up through the ranks of the National Park Service in Washington, DC, and continues to live in the area. She has been invited to join the meeting. Presentation by American University on proposed Meltzer Center/SCAN projects on main campus Cory Peterson, American University Assistant Vice President, Community and Government Relations, Office of People and External Affairs, will make a formal presentation on the proposed Alan and Amy Meltzer Center and Sports Center Annex (SCAN), in anticipation of the July 6 hearing before the DC Zoning Commission on this project, as part of the approved AU Campus Plan (ZC 20-31B). Mr. Peterson made a preliminary presentation on these projects at ANC 3A's public meeting on March 21, 2023.

DDOT Update on Traffic Safety Matters Affecting ANC 3A, including Projects and Initiatives Christian Piñeiro, DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) Office of Community Engagement Program Analyst for Ward 3, will discuss safety-related work by DDOT in the area, including safety concerns that have been raised by the ANC and residents, options available for safety improvements, and DDOT's TSI 2.0 process for dealing with service requests for traffic safety investigations.

Letter to DDOT about Scooter Corral on Fulton Street west of Wisconsin Avenue NW

DDOT installed a scooter corral on the south side of Fulton in April without notice or public comments. Residents have expressed concerns about reduced safety due to the narrowed roadway at that intersection. DDOT is offering a different location for the corral, which would require public notice and comment.

DC Department of Buildings introduction to programs on illegal construction and vacant buildings Janelle Williams and Jason Williamson of Department of Buildings (DOB) Account Management division will present information on the new agency's functions, focusing on illegal construction (requests for inspections, stop work orders, and the process after a property is identified as in violation) and on vacant buildings (the multi-agency approach to compliance enforcement of vacant buildings in the District).
