Expertly designed with our friends at the University of Minnesota, the Septic Mound Kit includes a collection of beautiful native flowers and grasses that will strive in drier, poorer quality soils (septic mound fill) while providing important ground cover to reduce erosion. Most importantly, these plants have small, fibrous root systems to prevent damage to underground septic system components.

Consider planting in full sunlight in well-drained soils on top of a septic mound.



RUSTY PATCH BUMBLE BEE - FULL SUN KIT

MNL has partnered with the Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources and the Lawns to Legumes program to design pollinator gardens to help create habitat for the endangered Rusty Patched Bumble Bee. Our Rusty Patched Bumble Bee Gardens are available in Full Sun, Part Shade, and Rain Garden varieties.

This rusty patch kit is for creating a pollinator garden within a yard and is a perfect fit for the Native Pocket Plantings in the Lawns to Legumes program. Consider planting in areas with mesic soil with large amounts of direct sunlight. We designed this collection to have flowering species in all the bloom seasons and to contain flowers that are of high priority and "superfoods" for the Rusty Patched Bumble Bee.


