In Red Deer, the Outdoor Covered Sand Arena will open at 12 noon Thursday afternoon. In Claresholm, arenas are open all day; however, please be respectful of boarders using the facility on Thursday. **Late Departures** must vacate the show grounds before 9am, Monday morning. **Stalls are non-refundable** without proof of veterinary or medical certificate, and must be submitted to the APHC prior to the start of the show. **Payments can be made by Cheque or e-transfer.** If you are submitting stall payment by cheque please ensure it will be received prior to deadline: Cheques payable to "APHC" and mailed to: APHC c/o Tessa Rupert, Box 511, Carbon, AB, TOM OLO. **Red Deer Westerner Park Camping:** Please reserve RV space using the APHC Stalls/Camping form. RULES & DETAILS

The 2024 APHA Rule Book is available online. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules of the classes they are entering. A full list of APHC Show Highpoint and Year End Award rules are available at [www.albertapainthorseclub.com].

The Master Entry form is to be completed per horse and must include current horse registration papers, APHA membership and applicable Youth, Amateur, Novice, or Walk Trot cards, and APHC membership cards, can be uploaded directly onto the form. Exhibitors are encouraged to apply for their APHA membership cards ahead of the show to avoid a late fee. Failure to submit a complete Master Entry will invoke the late fee.

Class entries and/or changes can be made at the show.

However, all class entries are encouraged to be made ahead of the show to simplify exhibitor check-in. Please remember to check in with the show office prior to your first class. Failure to check in may result in a late fee or missed classes. Office hours will be announced online ahead of the show.

Please notify the gate person of all scratches. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the gate person and show secretary are aware of any classes added or scratched!

APHC Memberships will not be available at the show. Please ensure you have submitted and paid your APHC membership prior to the start of the show. Membership form is available on the website at [www.albertapainthorseclub.com]. Only APHC members are eligible for the all-inclusive show fees. As per APHC Year End Rules, point accumulation will commence effective upon the date of membership. Points earned prior to paid membership will not be included.

Drug Testing: As per APHA regulations, all horses will be subject to random drug testing. This may include a urine and/or blood sample collected by a veterinarian or technician. Refusal of testing constitutes disqualification from the show, forfeiture of entry fees, prize monies and awards. This fee is not applied to horses only exhibited in Leadline. This fee is not included in all-inclusive or individual class fees.

Splitting & Combining classes: As per APHA rules, Show management may combine or split classes as justified by entries if there is unanimous consent of all involved exhibitors. However, in Open Performance classes, if one division does not have a one point earning class (three entries), then show management may combine age groups, without unanimous consent of all exhibitors, in order to make the division a one point earning division. In Amateur classes, show management may combine or split age divisions of Amateur exhibitors as justified by entries if there is unanimous consent of all involved exhibitors, however, if one age division is not a two point earning class, then show management may combine age divisions without unanimous consent of all exhibitors. In Youth classes, a 13 and Under exhibitor may choose which division to compete in on a per class basis but cannot exhibit in both divisions in the same class. For more details, please see the 2024 APHA Rule Book.

Performance Halter eligibility according to APHA rules states that horses must compete in a minimum of one performance class, other than showmanship, at the same show to be eligible. Horses can be shown in Western or English attire and are not eligible for other open halter classes if exhibiting in performance halter.

Futurity & Maturities: In all APHC hosted Futurity & Maturities (CCF, Signature Series, and Stakes), the horse owner must be a current APHC member in good standing.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times and cannot enter the show/warmup areas and stands.
