INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION for JACKSHAFT KIT Part No. 745-126

- Separate the drive chain by removing the retaining clip and the master connecting link.
- Loosen the set screws on the sprocket and unlock all bearing collars on the jackshaft.
- 3. Next slide the jack haft to the left until the sprocket can be removed from the jackshaft.
- 4. To install the jackshaft kit, install lock collar, spacers and sprocket in the order as shown in the diagram.
- 5. Next lock all bearing collars and their set screws.
- 6. Slide No. 1 spacer to the right up against the bearing lock collar.
- 7. Move the sprocket until its center aliens up with the center of the differential sprocket. With the key under the set screw lock the sprocket in place. NOTE: It may be necessary to cut the 1/4 sq. key to a 1" length.
- 8. Slide No. 2 spacer and lock collar up against the sprocket. Lock in place using the set screw which is in the lockcollar.
- 9. Connect the drive chain back together in the reverse process that you used to disconnect it.
