Service Credits How it works?

Each family (TK-8), in addition to tuition, is required to volunteer time and talent to St. Augustine School. There are numerous opportunities to do so throughout the year including, but not limited to, recess/lunch help, working a fundraiser or athletic event, or serving on the board of the Parent/Teacher Club, Athletic Association, or School Advisory Committee.

Requirements:

All school families are required to earn 23 Hours
15 of 23 hours must be worked during any school events
4 of 23 hours must be worked during the school's fundraising dinner or fish fry
4 of 23 hours must be worked at a parish event

Objectives:

The objectives of the service credit program are: I. To involve all parents/guardians of the students in the support and enrichment of the school's education and extracurricular activities 2 To belo maintain and improve the quality

 To help maintain and improve the quality of the educational programs and facilities at St. Augustine School through volunteer opportunities and successful fundraising activities.

Any adult member (16 years or older) is eligible to work
 In lieu of volunteering to earn service credits, a family can elect to pay\$25.00 per unworked service credit hour
 Parents of Athletes will have additional service credits to work
