**SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER / SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY**  
**SEGUNTO DOMINGO DE PASCUA / DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA**

FOCUS: We are called to live out God's mercy.

In today's Gospel, Jesus confers his divine power to forgive sins on the Apostles through the Holy Spirit. This forgiveness is still available to us in the sacraments. The gift of God's mercy calls us to also perform acts of mercy to ensure that, as in the earliest communities of believers, no one among us is in need.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD**

The first reading describes how the early community of believers held everything in common. In the second reading, John writes that to love God is to keep his commandments, and that faith in Jesus conquers the world. In the Gospel, Jesus appears to the disciples in a locked room and breathes on them, giving them the power to forgive sins.

ENFOQUE: Estamos llamados a vivir la misericordia de Dios.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús confiere a los Apóstoles, por medio del Espíritu Santo, su poder divino de perdonar los pecados. Este perdón sigue estando a nuestra disposición en los sacramentos. El don de la misericordia de Dios nos llama también a realizar actos de misericordia para que, como en las primeras comunidades de creyentes, nadie entre nosotros pase necesidad.

**LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA**

La primera lectura describe cómo la primitiva comunidad de creyentes tenía todo en común. En la segunda lectura, Juan escribe que amar a Dios es guardar sus mandamientos y que la fe en Jesús conquista al mundo. En el Evangelio, Jesús se aparece a los discípulos en una habitación cerrada y sopla sobre ellos, dándoles el poder de perdonar los pecados.

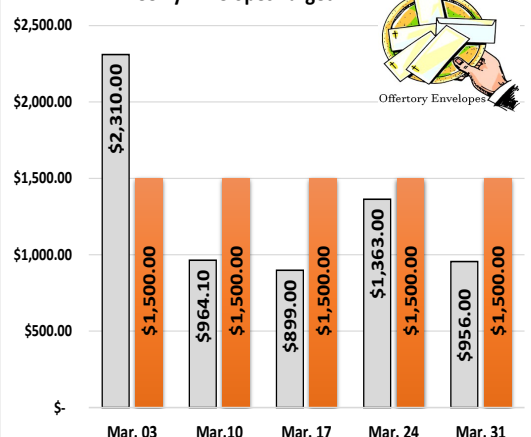

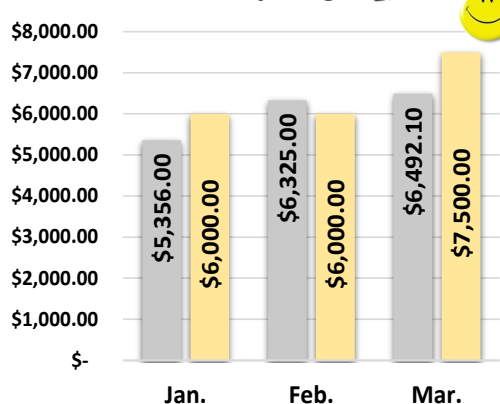

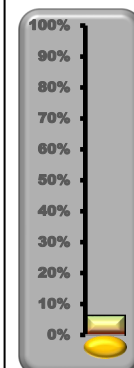
