Quartermaster's Report

The recent economic problems in our country have not gone unnoticed by the **Post**

Quartermaster's office.

The rising cost of diesel and gasoline have helped to drive up the cost of all the products

we purchase. In addition, most deliveries to the **Post** now have a fuel surcharge added. We are carefully monitoring all expenses to control our costs.



The loss of our **Sprint** cell tower revenue (due to the recent merger of **Sprint** and **T-Mobile**) is a significant loss of proceeds for the **Post**. However, we are negotiating with **T-Mobile** for new generator space. **AT&T** wants to put **Dish Network** on our property. When I became **Quartermaster**, we had six towers; now we are down to three. We do have another company that may come onto our location. Hopefully, we will be able to make up for the loss of **Sprint** revenue. I will continue to look for new tenants.
