In closing as always, I am honored to be your Commander and deeply appreciate all of you as members and patrons of this great **Post!**

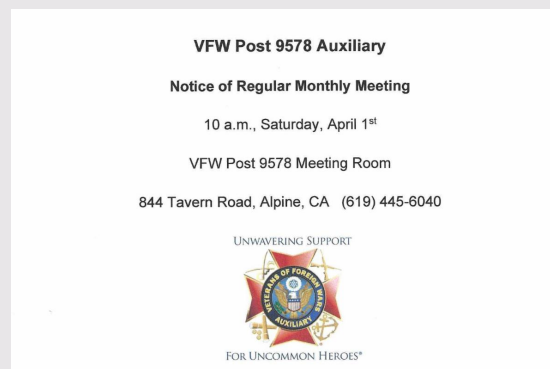
