Quartermaster's Message

Since I've been in the
Quartermaster
position for about six
months now, I thought
it would be important
for members to know
what the position
entails. Therefore, from the **VFW
Quartermaster's Guide** (2019 - 2020):
"The **Post Quartermaster** is the chief
financial officer of the **Post**. The
Quartermaster is the custodian of all **Post**
property and the officer responsible for
safeguarding **Post** funds and property. The
Quartermaster is accountable to the **Post**,
Department and the National Organization
for all the monies, securities, vouchers and
property of the **Post**. The **Quartermaster** is
the only one authorized under the Bylaws,
to receive, handle, and account for funds of
the **Post**. As **Quartermaster**, you may
authorize a person to disburse funds on
your behalf; however, they must be
bonded. There are no exceptions to this
rule!



No committee, holding company, canteen
manager, group or individual in the **Post** or
in any way connected with the **Post's**
activities, can take this authority and
responsibility from the **Post
Quartermaster**.

All funds, monies or property accumulated
under the name of the Veterans of Foreign
Wars for the **Post**, regardless of the nature
of the activity which accumulates them, are
the property of the **Post** and are subject
only to disposition by **Post** action.

In the 1840s, marketers began to see **Christmas** as a prime opportunity to sell goods. The first in-store Santa Claus appeared at Macy's in 1862. The retail sector has now expanded into such a gigantic, profitable industry that sometimes we may be literally distracted from the original intention that before any changes or developments took place.

Alabama was the first state to officially recognize **Christmas** in 1836.

However, the birth date of **Jesus** is still a mystery. The date of birth of **Jesus** is not stated in the gospels or in any historical sources. Most biblical scholars generally accept a date of birth between 6 BC and 4 BC, the year in which **King Herod** died.

Today's scholars believe that the main reason **Jesus'** birth came to be celebrated on **December 25th** is because that was the date of the **Winter Solstice** according to the Roman calendar.

Historians may not consider the **Bible** a complete historical document, but rather a supportive document used in concert with other, more accurate historical documents

So, why was **December 25** chosen as the birthday of **Jesus**?

The reason for the selection of Dec. 25 seems to have been that it is exactly nine months after **March 25**, the traditionally acknowledged date of **Jesus'** crucifixion. As Christians developed the theological idea that **Jesus** was conceived and crucified on the same date, they set the date of his birth nine months later.

Finally, The **New Testament** gives no information about what time of year **Jesus** was born.

What we really know for sure, **Jesus** was a Jew. He was born of a Jewish mother in **Galilee**, a Jewish part of the world. All of his friends, associates, colleagues, disciples were **Jews**. He regularly worshipped in Jewish communal
