

Spent Cases:

Police your firing area. **Please pick up all your brass** and either place it in the white plastic cans or take it home with you. Non-reloadable centerfire cases should be picked up and placed in the trash

Trash:

Please do NOT throw empty aerosol cans, batteries, and live/misfired ammunition into the trash drums. We burn our trash, and all these items can cause serious harm and damage when put into a fire.

Live / misfired ammunition should be removed from the range.

Zero-Tolerance Policy

The Headland Skeet & Gun Club has a Zero-Tolerance policy towards anyone found under the influence or using alcohol and/or illegal drugs while participating on any of our ranges. Anyone found in violation of this policy will be immediately brought before the board pending revocation of membership.
