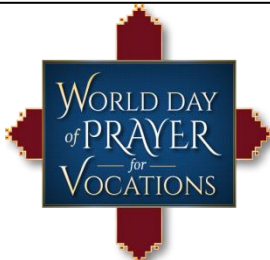

And, Jesus appears to the disciples again and again. We read, "but they were startled and terrified and thought they were seeing a ghost." Jesus seemed to be having a hard time getting the disciples to understand what resurrection really meant for Jesus and for the disciples. He again had them touch his wounds "because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." He then asks for a piece of fish and, "he took it and ate it in front of them."
