PASTOR’S MESSAGE

This weekend we welcome Fr. Dick Dickman to our parishes. Fr. Dickman and I met in the early 1980’s as we attended seminary together at St. Mary’s University in Winona. He has been a great friend for many years but still shows me no mercy in playing cribbage. Welcome Fr. Dick to Crucifixion and St. Patrick’s parishes.

St. Paul speaks to us this weekend and encourages us to focus our lives on God and the eternal life God brings. He says “look not to what is seen but to what is unseen; for what is seen is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal.” St. Paul was reminding the Corinthians and us not to seek salvation in the things of this world but rather in the unseen God. Money, power, possessions have no power to save us. It is through the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus that we find eternal life. May our lives reflect our desire to live always as brothers and sisters of Jesus.

In addition to my current assignment here at Crucifixion and at St. Patrick, on July 2 I will be appointed for one year the Parochial Administrator to the parishes of St. Joseph in Rushford, St. Peter in Hokah and St. Mary in Houston. The Diocesan offices are organizing the schedule for the Saturday and Sunday liturgies at these parishes. I will have the responsibility for everything else.

Weddings that were scheduled for this year all came on days that were free so there will be no conflict on those dates. I am going to move all council meetings, school board meetings, etc. to Tuesdays so that Wednesday evenings can be free for me to visit the Faith Formation classes at our parishes. Once I become the administrator, we will look at the needs of each parish for the visitation of care centers, homebound, and those who have special needs.

I know that this will be a time of transition for all of us. Schedules will need to be adjusted and some new opportunities for God’s grace will present itself. Please keep peaceful hearts in this time of change and trust that the Lord is present and God’s love will provide for our needs.
