PASTOR'S MESSAGE

This past week, Wednesday, we celebrated Independence Day. Unfortunately, for many people it was only different because it was a day off from work or a time to set off fireworks.

We truly live in a wonderful country. As citizens, we enjoy rights that many other people in the world can only dream about. Our freedoms and rights have been protected for us by many brave men and women who serve in our armed forces. Continue to give thanks to God in your prayers for the privilege of being a citizen of this country and for the safety of all who protect us in their service to our country.

There are, however, problems that need to be solved. I believe one need is for economic reform. This past week LaBron James, a professional basketball player, was given a four-year contract to play at a salary of \$154,000,000. This comes to 38 and one-half million dollars per year. If you work full time, the average income in Minnesota is around \$50,000. It would take a person 770 years to make what Mr. James is paid for playing for one year. Something seems wrong.
