SAFETY...Bob Walker...

I would be willing to bet that more electric RC planes were sold this year than ever before. Raise your hand if you got one. Better yet, bring it to Show and Tell at the next meeting then bring it to the field.

Toward the end of the flying season, more and more electric planes were showing up with new owners. Since the season is on hold with the weather, now is a good time to review some good practices.

The LiPo batteries for the electric planes hold a lot of energy. Never, ever walk away while the batteries are charging. While relatively safe, we still read way too often about a battery over heating or catching fire. It is a good idea to charge the batteries on a concrete surface or something not flammable.....just in case. After charging, store in a safe place. A LiPo bag would be a great after Christmas present for yourself if you do not have one. Some people use old ammo cans, but I have read how many have accidently slammed the battery lead in the lid, the battery shorts out and starts burning.....so always be careful.

The other situation to always be aware of is the arc of the prop. I still see many people reaching through the arc of the prop for whatever reason. This can be very dangerous when the airplane battery is armed. Even small electric motors and batteries pack a powerful punch. That is why the planes fly so well and so long. When a propeller gets resistance, such as with a finger in the prop, the battery supplies even more power to keep the rpms up. Cuts from electric planes can be worse than those of a glow or gas engine of the same size. So always be away of the hazard. As we say over and over.....THINK.
