April Club Meeting:

The April club meeting was held on Tuesday, April 11th at 7:00pm at the Havre de Grace Activity Center as planned. There were 7 members in attendance. The last club meeting was held on January 10th. Since we did not have any pressing issues to discuss or report there were no meetings held in February or March. The following points were discussed at the meeting.

Treasury Report:

Steve provided an update on the club's financial status through April 2023. The club's finances are in good shape. A handout was given to attending members. Please note we do not publish financial information online.

Membership Report:

Steve also provided an update on the club's membership tally as of the meeting. The club has 74 members signed up for the year so far.

Old Business:

- Field Updates:
 - <u>Tractor Maintenance & Supplies</u>: Steve has purchased the necessary supplies needed to service the 3 Zero-Turn tractors for this season. We will be servicing the equipment in April.
 - <u>1st Lawn Treatment</u>: The field received its 1st lawn treatment in April. This ongoing preventive maintenance will keep the runway and pit areas healthy and green throughout the year.
 - <u>Grass Cutting is Underway</u>: Grass cutting has already begun and the field is looking in fantastic shape for this year's flying season.

- Canopy Concrete Project:
 - The canopy concrete project has finally arrived. The contractor "Bowman" started the project on Thursday, April 12th and is expected to complete the work on Monday, April 17th, weather permitting. Please go easy on the fresh concrete until it fully cures during the next several months. This is another Swan Harbor RC accomplishment for the field and for all members to enjoy!
- Online Weather Station:
 - Steve and Ron installed the new Ambient Weather Network "Online" weather station in April. It is currently operating and can provide you with pertinent information about weather conditions directly from the field. See the mobile phone installation instructions in the Tech Section below and on the club's website in the Tech Section. Additionally, Steve sent out an email in April regarding the mobile app installation procedures.
- Security Camera System:
 - Steve and Ron installed a new security camera system at the field in April on the main shed. This will add another level of security that will allow us to see any issues like vandalism or weather destruction and hopefully identify what occurred.

Swan Harbor Park – Main Entrance Update & Plan:

<u>Steve's Update via email dated April 4th</u>: Last fall the county lost the caretaker for Swan Harbor Park. He was responsible for opening and closing the park from dawn to dusk. This is why they started closing the park at 5:00pm last November. A few weeks ago, I talked to the county about allowing us to use the park after 5:00pm and the county agreed to just dummy lock the gate so we could have access. Today, the county has notified me that they will no longer be "dummy" locking the gate and will be locking the park at 5:00pm. Their reasoning for the change is the county has set up expensive catering equipment and a large party tent to support this year's weddings and other events and they are worried about protecting this equipment from vandalism.

I know this is a problem for our club members who work during the week and with frequent weekend TFRs, this leaves no time for working members to enjoy our field and fly.

We've discussed this with the director of parks and recreation and he is very sympathetic to our issue. His office is taking several steps to resolve this issue:

- <u>First</u>, they are looking for a new caretaker and expects to have a new person in place by June.
- <u>Secondly</u>, they will be replacing the current front gate with a new gate that will automatically open at dawn and close at dusk. The gate will also have an automatic sensor to open the gate should you be in the park after the gate closes. They are installing a sensor so when you pull up to the gate it will

automatically open and allow you to exit. The county expects to have the gate installed by Memorial Day.

In the meantime, the director has offered to allow us to have a dedicated evening for flying, say every Wednesday night. We would then be responsible for closing and locking the main gate when we leave. So, we have put together the following plan of action to help with member evening and weekend flying:

- <u>Wednesday Evening Flying Night</u>: We will adopt every Wednesday afternoon & evening as a planned flying session until the new gate system is installed and working. Steve or another volunteer will be responsible for locking up the main gate at the end of the night's flying. Who knows maybe this will be the start of some regular summer evening flying for members.
- <u>Swan Harbor Park Events</u>: GOOD NEWS! Steve has also obtained the Swan Harbor Park events schedule for April through October 2023. The main gate will be open late in the evening while events are going on at the park. So, you will be able to fly during these times without the worry of locking up the park. However, we can't help with any TFR's in effect during these times.

The club will hold its annual <u>Open House Fun Fly</u> on Saturday, June 10th starting at 10am. An email invitation was sent out to local area clubs, like prior years, to come and join us for the day. We will have the same lunch items as last year which will include grilled hamburgers, chips, cookies, and a soft drink for a nominal price yet to be determined.

We will be asking for some volunteers to help with certain duties like lunch preparation and cooking, cash box, and some light duty parking. We will also try to get the ice cream vendor back again if he can be reached and is still in business.

So, we are challenging all members to get out to the field in advance and get in some flying practice to be ready for the Fun Fly. We are hoping for a great turn out this year.

Tech Section:

Swan Harbor RC "New" On-Site & On-Line Weather Station March 2023

On March 29, 2023, a new weather station was installed at the Swan Harbor RC flying field. This new weather station was introduced at several club meetings in 2022 by Steve Snyder and was promised to be operational in early spring 2023. It is now operational and this document will explain the components of the system and how you can use it. The weather station has been installed in the main shed. You can see the key indicators from the weather station display inside the shed but you can also install the weather station's app on your smart phone and get all of the same weather indicators via the internet.

The components of the weather station are as follows:

- <u>Weather station</u>: Ambient Weather Station WS5000
- Verizon: TCL Link Zone 5G MiFi











Instructions for installing and setting up the Ambient Weather station "APP" on your smart phone:


<u>Step 1</u>: Download the <u>Ambient Weather Network (AWN</u>) "APP" from your smart phone's applicable "App Store" to your phone.




<u>Step 2</u>: Open the <u>Ambient Weather Network (AWN</u>) app on your phone and click on the <u>LOGIN</u> bar to create your own personal account. You will need your own account to access the Swan Harbor RC weather station.



After the AWN app opens, click on the LOGIN bar to create your own personal AWN account



<u>Step 3:</u> LOGIN to the Ambient Weather Network (AWN) app with your new LOGIN credentials:



Location Services option to allow the Ambient Weather app to use your location. You can choose <u>Allow While</u> <u>Using App</u> so the AWN app can operate normally.

<u>Step 4</u>: Navigate to the Swan Harbor RC Weather Station link:

After successfully logging in to the AWN app, type in <u>Swan Harbor RC</u> in the search field to navigate to the Swan Harbor RC weather station. Once you see the Swan Harbor RC link, click on it and it will take you to the Swan Harbor RC weather station data. You will then be able to scroll through all of the SHRC weather station indicators.

Currently the weather station online indicators are updated every minute.

You do not have to log out of the app and is entirely your option.




