## July Club Meeting

### Treasury & Membership:

Steve started the meeting by providing an update on the club's financial status as of July 2023. Please be assured the club's finances are in good shape. A handout will be given to the attending members. Please note we do not publish financial information online.

Steve also provided an update on the club's membership status as of the July meeting. The club now has 79 members for 2023. New members have been spotted actively flying and enjoying the club's great facility. Welcome aboard!

### **Old Business:**

 Swan Harbor Farm main gate update: The new gate has been installed and the electrical connections have been completed. Reflector signs have been ordered for the gate since it is black and may be missed at dusk. As soon as the signs have been received and installed the gate will become fully operational.



- The gate's operating hours will be 6:00am till 8:00pm daily.
- There is a trip pressure sensor on the road just in front of the gate that will open the gate in case you leave the park after 8:00pm. Slowly pull up to the gate until you see the gate open and you may leave unattended.
- The caretaker's house renovation has been completed and a new caretaker is expected to be hired and in service by the end of July 2023.
- The old gate will be used only as a backup to the new gate when needed.

- <u>Wednesday Evening Flying</u>: We will be continuing on with the weekly Wednesday afternoon & evening flying since it has been well received by members and seems to be a big success. We will notify you in advance if we have to cancel a day due to bad weather or other circumstances. When available we have been grilling cheeseburgers between 5-6 pm.
- RC Stuff Donated by Larry Kirssin's Family: At the August club meeting we will have the last of Larry Kirssin's RC stuff to give away which will include various miscellaneous electric motors, esc's, receivers, mounts, jumpers, and LIPOs. Come to the meeting and see if there is something you can use.
- <u>Flying Safety Etiquette</u>: Safety is always the main concern while flying Radio Control aircraft. Now that the weather is prime time for flying and there are more fliers coming out, we feel it is a good time to advise you and request that we all follow some good flight line etiquette and flying safety rules <u>when there are other active fliers in the air</u>.
  - <u>Announce Your Flying Intentions</u>: Always announce to the other active fliers on the flight line of your flying intentions like <u>TAKING-OFF</u> or <u>LANDING</u>. This verbal announcement will give the other fliers a heads-up as to what you are going to do so they can be ready for your flight action.
  - <u>TAKE-OFF</u> and <u>LAND</u> into the <u>Wind</u>: Always plan to <u>TAKE-OFF</u> and <u>LAND</u> your plane into the current wind direction. Refrain from cross runway TAKE-OFFs. This method of flying will not only make your flying more successful but it will provide an unspoken action that will help the active flier immediately know what you are doing as well.
  - Fly the Pattern with Active Fliers: Always try to fly the oval flying pattern when you are flying with other active fliers. You can think of this in terms of the NASCAR oval track pattern. TAKE-OFF into the wind and turn 180 degrees to fly in the down wind direction away from the runway. Then LAND into the wind on the runway when you are ready.

### **New Business:**

Dale "Maniac" Davis passing and "Celebration of Life Service"

With Dale's passing, the executor of his estate asked if the Swan Harbor RC club would host a memorial service for Dale at the field. After conversations with the staff at the Swan Harbor Farm, they offered their reception tent and main house facility to us so we could hold the service there. It worked out beautifully.

On Sunday July 16th from 1:00 PM till 3:00 PM we successfully held the memorial for Dale at the Swan Harbor Farm facility. Cupcakes, a cake with Dale's picture on it and bottled water was served as refreshments. Approximately 60 people showed up including club members, Raven's super fans, friends, and Harford County staff including Paul Magness, Director of Harford County Parks and Recreation.

Steve set up some of Dale's memorabilia like pictures of him in his Raven's super fan attire, his large X-Cub and Skydiver "Steven", and his Swan Harbor RC painted car, etc. There was an open microphone for people to share stories and memories about Dale.

Dale's executor asked that instead of sending flowers, contributing to a memorial fund for Dale would be more desirable. The executor published the link to all of Dale's friends throughout the county.

Steve Snyder gave a heartfelt opening testimonial at Dale's memorial gathering and asked if any participants wanted to share some of their memories of Dale. Dale would have been happy and proud of the turnout and kind words said by all.

#### A memorial for Dale at the field:

At the July meeting, Steve discussed and proposed setting up something at the field for us to remember Dale and all of his accomplishments for the club. He proposed a sturdy park bench with engraved pavers on the ground for fallen members. This would be placed in front of Dale's garden facing the field next to the bulletin board.

Lewis Fillinger has offered to help make the bench from concrete molds he uses when making benches for other uses. The bench will have concrete sides and some type of wooden or synthetic slats for the seat and back rest. Steve would like to make the slats Lime Green which is Dale's favorite color. The current picture signs of fallen members in the garden will be replaced with the above mentioned engraved pavers.

#### **New Membership Dues:**


Full year new membership: \$130.00


○ <u>Joining period</u>: 1/1/YR thru 12/31/YEAR (\*)

The reason for this exception is that the current flying season is about 75% over and we want to give new members an incentive to join our club.
