• <u>Swan Harbor Park</u> – Main Entrance Update:

<u>Current update</u>: The new gate has been installed and will be a side opening style gate not a swing out gate. The last step is the electrical hook up. The hope is that the gate is operational very soon.

In the meantime:

• <u>Wednesday Evening Flying</u>: We have adopted every Wednesday afternoon & evening as a planned flying session until the new gate system is installed and working. Steve or another volunteer will be responsible for locking up the main park gate at the end of the night's flying. Who knows maybe this will be the start of some regular summer evening flying for members.

- <u>Swan Harbor Park Events</u>: GOOD NEWS! Steve has also obtained the Swan Harbor Park events schedule for April through October 2023. The main gate will be open late in the evening while events are going on at the park. So, you will be able to fly during these times without the worry of locking up the park. However, we can't help with any TFR's in effect during these times. Here are the current 2023 Swan Harbor Park event dates:

#### New Business:

• <u>RC Stuff Donated by SHRC Member "Larry Kirssin"</u>:

Long time member, Larry Kirssin, unfortunately cannot fly RC any longer so he and his son have <u>donated</u> all of Larry's RC stuff to be distributed amongst our club members. Many thanks to Larry and his son. We will be bringing Larry's stuff to the monthly cub meetings until it all has been distributed to new happy owners.

#### <u>Safety Tips – Flight Line Etiquette:</u>

Safety is always the main concern while flying Radio Control aircraft. Now that the weather is prime time for flying and there are more fliers coming out, we feel it is a good time to advise you and request that we all follow some good flight line etiquette and flying safety rules when there are other active fliers in the air.

- <u>Announce Your Flying Intentions</u>: Always announce to the other active fliers on the flight line of your flying intentions like <u>TAKING-OFF</u> or <u>LANDING</u>. This verbal announcement will give the other fliers a heads-up as to what you are going to do so they can be ready for your flight action.
- <u>TAKE-OFF and LAND into the Wind</u>: Always plan to <u>TAKE-OFF</u> and <u>LAND</u> your plane into the current wind direction. Refrain from cross runway TAKE-OFFs. This method of flying will not only make your flying more successful but it will provide an unspoken action that will help the active flier immediately know what you are doing as well.
- <u>Fly the Pattern with Active Fliers</u>: Always try to fly the oval flying pattern when you are flying with other active fliers. You can think of this in terms of the NASCAR oval track pattern. TAKE-OFF into the wind and turn 180 degrees to fly in the down wind direction away from the runway. Then LAND into the wind on the runway when you are ready.
