Greetings as we continue our Lenten journey towards Easter morning! Three more Sundays in Lent, then Palm Sunday also known as Passion Sunday, and finally Easter that, fittingly, falls on the last day of the month. Too often we like to jump from Palm Sunday to Easter, remembering the happy times, the celebration. But that last week of our Savior's life, that Holy Week, is seven important days long. It is a journey to the cross and beyond, a journey full of pain and betrayal, a journey that changed the world and each of our lives forever. So, this year we have planned a full week of services in order that we might all journey each day along with our Lord.

We will begin our week with a traditional Palm Sunday service as we all join the procession waving our palm leaves. On Holy Monday Jesus visits at Lazarus' home in Bethany and is anointed with costly nard by Lazarus' sister, Mary. We will post a brief Holy Monday service on our Facebook page that you may view at your convenience. On Tuesday Jesus explains that unless a grain of wheat falls to the earth and dies, it cannot bear fruit. A Holy Tuesday service will also be posted on our Facebook page for your viewing. On Spy Wednesday, as Jesus speaks of His upcoming betrayal, our regular mid-week Lenten service will be held at 12:15 and will include a healing service. On the day of our Lord's Last Supper we will have a full Maundy Thursday service at 7:00 pm with a final stripping of the alter. Our Good Friday service will also be at 7:00 and will include the Solemn Reproaches. Then finally, gloriously, the day that our Savior saved the world, our Easter morning service will be at 9:30.

By the way, does Easter seem early to you this year? The date for Easter, around which the rest of our church year revolves, is not a random selection. The ancient tradition says Easter falls on the first Sunday on or after the first full moon following the spring equinox (March 21). So, technically, Easter can fall anywhere from March 22 to April 25. Lent is counted backward from Easter to get the date for Ash Wednesday and we count forward from Easter to decide the date of Pentecost. May these final days of Lent and the Holy Week bring you rebirth and rejuvenation, peace and comfort. Amen.
