Dear Neighbors,

Happy Summer to the community! The Easter Egg Hunt and Yard sale filled the community with activities this Spring. Many neighbors are enjoying the warm weather, walking their dogs, and visiting each other.

If you do walk dog, please pick up after your dog. Hampton Elementary School has asked us to remind the community not to walk your dog on the property during school hours. If you must bring your dog to pick up your child, please have it on its leash. Let's be considerate of the school grounds and children who are not familiar with dogs.

For the last 3 years our monthly meetings were on Zoom, and on June 12th we held our first hybrid meeting. We secured a room at Valley Baptist Church and had the ability to Zoom for those unable to attend in person. We will be taking the summer break for July and August returning in September for in-person meetings at Valley Baptist Church. The DVIA Board will communicate to the community via email regarding the current appeal and special zoning hearing meetings.

We have met with the attorney and filed an appeal. The appeals process was started because our community, who is next to the property, was not allowed to speak at the Baltimore County meeting – we couldn't ask questions, we could not express concerns for the building site location, style, or height of the building, nor the easements from York Road or Greenridge Road. We are now appealing the verdict given to Two Farms, Inc. granting a limited exemption under the Baltimore County Code allowing them to build on the site without any community involvement.

New in Baltimore County: Textile Recycling







Made possible by a partnership with Helpsy, you can now recycle textile waste in Baltimore County. Residents can now recycle clothing, shoes, backpacks, sheets, towels, blankets, curtains, throw rugs and other household textiles in Helpsy clothing collection containers at any of the County's three drop-off facilities. Items must be clean, dry, odorless, and bagged. Where does it go? 95% of what is collected is reused, upcycled, or recycled. Typically, 50% is reusable, 45% is recyclable.




