





Piedmont Division Model Train Show

The Georgia Garden Railway Society will host a layout on Saturday, March 9th, 10:00 to 5:00, and Sunday, March 10th, 10:00 to 4:00, at the **Piedmont Division Model Train Show**. The show will be held at the Clarence Brown Conference Center, 5450 Georgia Highway 20, Cartersville, Georgia. The show features 8 operating layouts of various model train scales, a White Elephant sale, raffle layout, vendors, and a train set give - away. Admission is \$10 (kids under 10 are free); however, for \$25 you can be admitted on Saturday at 9:00 a.m. for early bird opportunities.

The GGRS layout will feature a Wild West theme. Volunteers to help manage our layout are asked to identify a specific 2-hour period and day on which they can assist. Of course, volunteering for more than one period is welcome. Secretary Pam Williamson will send out a list of time slots for your consideration in signing up to allow us to plan our manpower (and womanpower) effectively. Volunteers simply enlighten visitors to our layout of the thrills of G - Scale Railroading and ensure trains stay on track.

Slots for hosting our membership table and registering participants for the 2024 G-Scale Southeast Regional Get-Together have been filled, but additional help is always welcome.





Early Registration Encouraged

Since the GGRS sponsored 2024 G-Scale Southeast Regional Get-Together is a 1-time event, we cannot easily estimate the number of garden railroaders planning to attend. Several hundred are certainly expected, but 1500 is possible. Regardless, the Friday night dinner on August 23rd is limited to the first 100 paid registrants presently. The low cost of \$25 may encourage higher participation than is usual for an eating event. Participation in the GGRS White Elephant Sale is also limited in number of spaces, as are the number of convention or get-together cars that will be sold.

Thus, we encourage GGRS families to register as early as possible. A registration form is in this issue of the newsletter and is posted on our website. Early registration will also help the planning committee fund their areas of responsibility more economically and perhaps allow expanded funding in such areas as door prizes or planning additional events such as clinics based on attendance figures.

Invitation to the 2024 G-Scale Southeast Regional Get-Together Friday, August 23rd – Sunday, August 25th

During most years since 1985, there has been a G-Scale garden railroading national convention hosted annually by different large scale model train clubs across the country even though there is no actual national garden railroading organization. The host organization selected at the previous convention becomes the national organization in the year they are the host. Unfortunately, no national convention will be hosted for 2024 since no one volunteered to host it. However, smaller regional get-togethers have been encouraged to take place. As such, the Georgia Garden Railway Society (GGRS) elected to partner with the multi-scale 65th Atlanta Model Train Show to be held at the Gas South Convention Center, 6400 Sugarloaf Parkway, Duluth, Georgia 30097, on Saturday, August 24th, to host a G-Scale Southeast Regional Get-Together that will feature:

- Up to 10 self-guided metro-Atlanta area garden railway tours daily on Friday, August 23rd, and Sunday, August 25th. Also some out-of-area garden railway tours off selected major Interstates on Thursday, August 22nd, and Sunday, August 25th;
- Tours of the new warehouse facility for nationally known model train retailer TRAINZ on Friday, August 23rd;
- An optional indoor Get Together Dinner on Friday evening of August 23rd featuring door prizes; suggestions for area dining, entertainment, and train venues; and a preview of train show vendors;
- An enhanced G-scale vendor presence at the 65th Atlanta Model Train Show in Duluth, Georgia, on Saturday, August 24th, including a multi-table White Elephant Sale by GGRS members; and G scale oriented "how-to" and railroad history clinics.

Since the model train show is a fixed venue, GGRS arranged with the closest motel, Embassy Suites, to block off a number of rooms for get-together attendees and to allow those attending our G-scale activities to pick up get-together packages at Embassy Suites. A link to special rates will be posted at our website: www.ggrs.info.

Registration Package will include driving instructions and a schedule of garden railroad yard tours hosted by members of the Georgia Garden Railway Society (9:00-4:00 Friday and Sunday), a \$1 discount coupon for each family member toward admission to the 65th Atlanta Model Train Show on August 24th (parking is a separate fee), 2 get-together pins for a family registration, driving instructions and any passes you may have purchased to the Friday evening get-together dinner, get-together car if ordered, a list of G-scale vendors at the train show and other information. The Registration Package will be available at the host hotel lobby of Embassy Suites, 2029 Satellite Blvd., Duluth, GA 30097, one block from the convention center on Thursday evening from 4:00-7:00 and Friday morning 7:00-9:00. Late arrivals can also obtain the package at the dinner Friday evening or at the GGRS Membership Table at the convention center on Saturday.

Dinner Get-Together on Friday night will be a picnic buffet at the nearby **Gwinnett County Bethesda Park Senior Center** at 225 Bethesda Church Road, Lawrenceville, Georgia 30046, from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. and will feature door prizes, raffles, tips on additional area shopping and train venues, and more. There is no entrance or parking fee at the dinner site.

There will be no bus services provided for this or other Get - Together venues.

A get-together car is available. Details are forthcoming. Registrants will be updated on this and other get - together news on a monthly basis.

Bargains in the Garden - White Elephant Sale

GGRS members interested in selling any of their G-gauge accessories can reserve 1 of 12 2-foot by 3-foot tabletop areas as part of a planned 3-table vendor display hosted by the Georgia Garden Railway Society on **Saturday, August 24th, at the 65th Atlanta Model Train Show** as part of the **2024 G-Scale Southeast Regional Get-Together**. The member need not be in attendance to use one of the spaces or to set up their items, but they must be a GGRS member registered for the convention get-together. All items must be clearly marked with a sales tag that cites their last name, short item description, and selling price so any volunteer manning the tables can sell an item without reference to the owner. Items must be functional and undamaged or marked "As Is" with a description of any defect. Items without this information will be removed from the sales tables. Any item sold at a lower price will be marked as such since the sales tag and all sales proceeds will be combined together. Each member will be returned their items and sales proceeds after the show. Unsold items may be placed for sale at the next one or two scheduled GGRS meetings if desired. Unsold items not retrieved within 60 days become the property of GGRS.

Members are <u>limited to one such slot per family</u> and must reserve the slot prior to July 14 (the day after our July membership meeting) with a \$20 donation to "GGRS" given to White Elephant Coordinator Terry Manning (temanning@aol.com). A space can be "built up" by stacking items such as boxed rolling stock or using a crate or something similar to create a raised shelf and may also use the floor space beneath their slot (thus doubling their available space). Unsold spaces will be used to enlarge paid spaces.

Participation is on a paid first-come basis to the first 12 participants. Items for sale need not be provided at time of payment reservation. 2024 G-Scale Southern Regional Get Together by Ted Yarborough

The Georgia Garden Railway Society (GGRS) is proud to announce they will host the **2024 G-Scale Southern Regional Get** - **Together** August 23-25, 2024. The event will be centered around the 65th Atlanta Model Train Show held at the Gas South Convention Center, formerly the Infinite Energy Center, Duluth, GA on Saturday, August 24. Layout tours of GGRS garden railroads will be held on Friday, August 23 and Sunday, August 25. A special gathering for a meal will be held Saturday night August 24th at the Southeastern Railway Museum, Duluth, GA.

The Embassy Suites, Duluth, GA will be headquarters for the event. Attendees will be able to pick up their registration packet at the hotel Thursday evening, August 22 or Friday morning, August 23. The lobby will be available for socializing Thursday and Friday evenings as well. The special rate of \$189 for a King Studio or \$199 for a Queen Suite, both are a short 10-minute walk to train show hall and include breakfast, just follow the link on the GGRS web page to get rooms at the 2024 G-Scale Regional Get - To-gether rates. Limited rooms available.

Garden railroad layout tours will be held on Friday and Sunday. GGRS members east and north of Atlanta will generally open on Friday and those south and west of Atlanta will open on Sunday. A few exceptions will be noted in the tour booklet. The tour booklet will be in your registration bag, along with a special commemorative pin. The booklet will have a brief description, physical GPS address, phone number, and photo of the garden railroads open. There are currently 12 GGRS layouts plus a Train Installations shop and TRAINZ new warehouse to tour (we're still recruiting). All tours will be self-guided.

The Saturday train show, Atlanta's Oldest and Largest Model Train and Railroadiana Show, is an all-scale train show which will serve as the Vendor Hall. There will be operating layouts as well as some well-known Atlanta vendors including TRAINZ, Split Jaw, Train Installations and MELOVESTRAINS plus many other G-scale vendors. If you would like to become a vendor or exhibitor, contact Charlie Miller at <u>RRSHOWS@AOL.COM</u> or 703-536-2954. There is a \$9.00 additional admission to the show (with discount coupon provided in registration bag).

Optional activities in Atlanta for Saturday include Stone Mountain Park with a 5-mile diesel train ride around the mountain, The Southern Museum featuring the 4-4-0 Civil War locomotive 'General', and the Southeastern Railway Museum with lots of locomotives and rolling stock on display. Take time after enjoying the train show to enjoy these train themed activities.

If there is enough interest, there will also be a separate purchase collectible G Scale train car. It will be a unique L & N freight car from USA Trains. Advance orders will be taken at the registration page and cars can be picked up at registration or the show.

To have the registration bags with name tags, pins, and tour booklets ready for August, we are asking for advance registration for the event. **The registration will be \$25.00 per individual registration and \$35.00 per family (up to two adults and two children)** registration prior to JUNE 1, 2024. Late registration, after JUNE 1, will increase to \$40.00 per individual and \$50.00 per family registration. 

FIRE DAMAGES KITCHEN AND LOBBY OF POPULAR RESTAURANT & SMORGASBORD

Bird-in-Hand, PA, January 31, 2024 – Bird-in-Hand Family Restaurant & Smorgasbord experienced a fire that damaged its kitchen and front lobby area.

Firefighters from Hand-in-Hand Fire Company and other neighboring companies were dispatched to the scene at 10:50 p.m. on Tuesday, January 30, and fought the blaze for about three hours.

"We are grateful for the rapid response from our local emergency services departments, and most grateful that no one was hurt," said John E. Smucker, II, Bird-in-Hand's president and chief executive officer. "Our fire protection system was a remarkable deterrent to contain greater damage."

The restaurant is currently closed, and the cause of the fire and extent of the damage are being assessed.

The restaurant was closed for 10 days in December following a fire at the adjacent Bird-in-Hand Family Inn. Prior to the December 28 reopening, the restaurant's structure, gas line and tanks, heating/ventilation/air conditioning, water and electrical systems passed extensive safety inspections. Our <u>Bird-in-Hand Family Restaurant & Smorgasbord</u> is temporarily closed due to a fire that damaged the kitchen and front lobby area.

At this point, the cause of the fire is unknown.

Moving forward

We are committed to rebuilding and reopening, just as we have at the Family Inn. We hope to announce a Restaurant reopening date after we have assessed the extent of the damage. At this point, we are also evaluating when we can open our <u>2024 Stage season</u>.

In the meantime, we are still serving guests at our <u>Bird-in-Hand Bakery & Cafe</u>, which is operating on its normal schedule, as are the Family Inn and Artisan Village.

We are exploring ways to continue to serve our dining guests and to support the 95 restaurant employees who, through no fault of their own, were displaced by the fire. We have established a <u>GoFundMe</u> page where those who choose to can donate funds to help these employees replace lost wages and benefits during the time the restaurant is closed.

We are grateful for your ongoing support, and for your thoughts, prayers and contributions at this difficult time.




