

WHAT RIGHTS ARE THEY VIOLATING? Federal Constitution

Article 6, paragraph 2- Constitution is the "supreme law of the land"

1st Amendment- Congress shall make no law prohibiting free exercise of religion and "right of the people" to peaceably assemble (has someone denied your religious freedoms or required 'social distancing' unlawfully?)

4th Amendment- right of the people to be "secure in their persons" against unreasonable search & seizure (are you being forced to 'test' without a warrant or probable cause?)

5th Amendment- no person shall be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law (are people being fired when there is no law requiring masks, testing and vaccinations?)

CA Constitution

Article 1- Declaration of Rights

Sec 1-- All people are by nature free and independent and have **inalienable** rights. Among these are enjoying and defending life and liberty, acquiring, possessing, and protecting property, and pursuing and obtaining safety, happiness, and privacy

Sec 2-- A law may not restrain or abridge liberty of speech or press.

Sec 4-- Free exercise and enjoyment of religion without discrimination or preference are guaranteed.

Sec 9-- A bill of attainder, **ex post facto law**, or law impairing the obligation of contracts may not be passed. (are new 'laws' making once legal things, illegal? breaching contracts?)

Sec 13-- The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects against unreasonable seizures and searches may not be violated;

Sec 17-- Cruel or unusual punishment may not be inflicted or excessive fines imposed (is losing your job for exercising your medical freedom cruel or unusual?)

Sec 24-- This declaration of rights may not be construed to impair or deny others retained by the people.
