**TYRRELLS EQUINE CLINIC RING
(Ridden)**

Ring to commence at 9am

- Class 11 TACK AND TURNOUT
Open to all, including lead rein. To be judged on the overall appearance of both horse and rider
- Class 12 NOVICE RIDDEN
Open to any horse/rider combinations who have never won a showing class. Competitors will only be required to walk and trot. Class may be split horse/pony if entries permit. Double Bridles not permitted.
- Class 13 LOCAL RIDING HORSE/PONY
Open to any horse or pony from within a 15 mile radius of the showground. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces. Class may be split horse/pony if entries permit
- Class 14 RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY
Open to any horse or pony who is suitable to be a member of a riding club. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces, to include a small jump. Class may be split horse/pony if entries permit
- Class 15 RIDDEN HUNTER TYPE
Open to any Horse or Pony over 4 years old. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces
- Class 16 RIDDEN COLOURED
Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Odd-Coloured, Roan, Dun and Spotted. Horse/Pony must be 4 years and over. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces
- Class 17 RIDDEN PART BRED
Open to any Horse or Pony over 4 years old. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces
- Class 18 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE/PONY
Open to any horse or pony 15 years and over. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces. Class may be split horse/pony if entries permit
- Class 19 RIDDEN FOREIGN BREED
Open to any breed not native to Great Britain. Horse/Pony must be 4 years and over.

Open to 1st and 2nd placed competitors in classes 12-19

General Show Rules

1. Competitors enter at their own risk. The organisers cannot be responsible for any accident, loss or injury to any animal, competitor, their assistants, property or spectators however caused.
2. The committee reserve the right to cancel any class or substitute any judge.
3. The committee reserve the right to reject or cancel the entry or entries made by any person if they deem it fit to do so.
4. The committee reserve the right to restrict entries in any class should numbers warrant.
5. The judge's decision is final.
6. Horses and ponies are liable to be measured if required.
7. Horse and ponies may have their passports checked.
8. No person other than the Show Officials and competitors at the time of competing are allowed in the show ring.
9. Competitors are not allowed to exercise their horses within the spectator areas and should keep to the horsebox area or any other designated area.
10. No galloping on the showground is permitted.
11. The correct attire, footwear and riding hats should be worn at all times when riding.
12. Unless a time has been specified in the schedule, classes follow on from each other immediately and it is the responsibility of the competitor to be ready to compete when the class is called.
13. Objections must be made within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 which will be returned should your objection be upheld. Any objection will be considered by the committee whose decision is final, from which there will be no appeal.
14. The area reserved for parking on the Horse Show site is reserved for Horseboxes and Horse Trailers only.
15. No refunds will be given after the close of entries unless the withdrawal is accompanied by either a doctor or vet's certificate. There will be no refund of entries taken on the day.
16. All trophy winners will be required to pay a deposit of £20.00 which will be fully refundable on return of the trophy the following year.
