Since I am unable to do that, this will be a "big picture" interpretation of my loved one. (A humorous thought I had while working on it, "it's her with a bad make-up job!). The project is starting to grow on me and making me smile.

Yet, doesn't this sound like life? A situation arises. It calls for a new approach. Perhaps it requires a different and/or new structure. This entails

risk taking. A work-in-progress ensues. Results may or may not be as you envisioned. Hopefully you smile through it.

For me, this experience has enriched my life. When I see examples of Chigiri-e, I totally appreciate the skill, the creativity, and the beauty of it. My *primitive* style of Chigiri-e makes me grin.
