

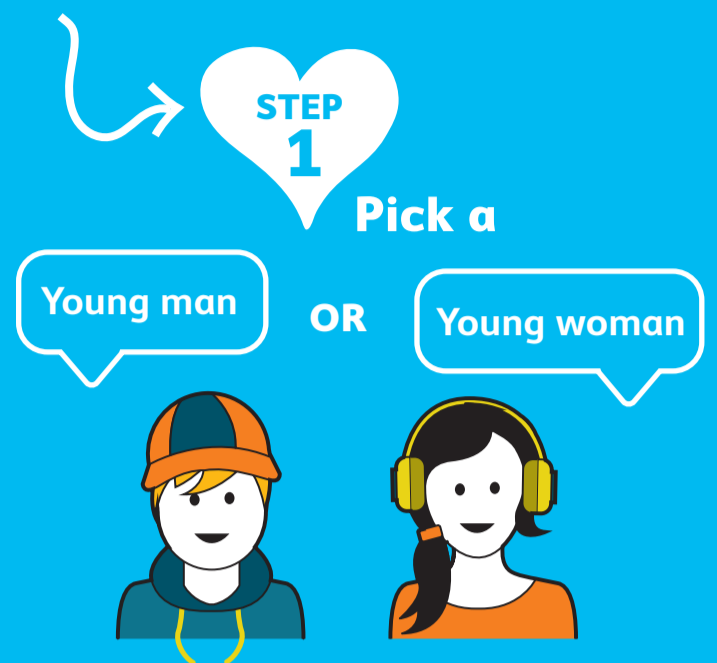
Transient Teenager Toiletry Bag

More than 2,500 teenagers and young adults are in care, transient, or living on their own as they transition to independence in Western Australia. This can have an impact on their capacity to maintain personal hygiene.

Care Bags has created Transient Teenager Toiletry Bags (TTT Bags) to support transient teens in care. The TTT Bags provide essential items needed to maintain personal hygiene and at the same time promote a sense of self-worth and self-esteem.

TTT Bags are donated to Communities, Child Protection and Family Support offices across Western Australia and given to young people when they visit their Case Managers.

How to build a TTT Bag



- All items must be new in original packaging
- All items must fit into the bag and it must close
