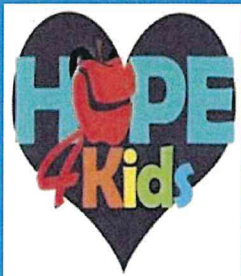


## **Circle of Friends**

Below is the recipe courtesy of Elaine Nicholls:

1  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup quick oats  
1 cup flour  
1 cup brown sugar, firmly packed  
1 tsp. baking powder  
1 tsp. almond extract  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup butter  
1-12 oz. jar preserves or jam, any flavor

Stir together oats, flour brown sugar, baking powder, and almond extract. Cut in butter until coarse crumbs form. Press 3 c. of mixture into greased 9" square pan. Spread with jam, leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ " border along sides. Top with remaining crumbs. Bake at 375 for 25-30 minutes. Cool before cutting.

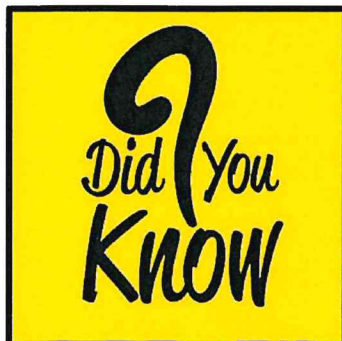

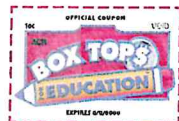

Week 4: We learned about intercessory prayer and practiced praying in color.

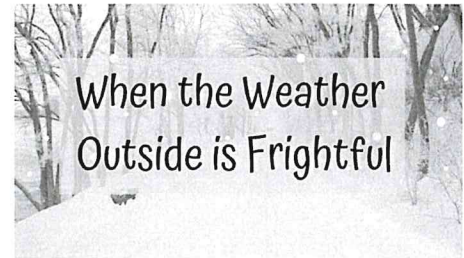
Week 5: This week we will talk about tying action to prayer and what it looks like to follow through on "Sending thoughts and prayers," to someone in need.
