<p>Edgecliff Town Council Elections are held annually on the first Saturday in May with Places 1, 2, and 3 appearing on the ballot in even-numbered years; and the Mayor and Places 4 and 5 in odd- numbered years. Special elections are held as necessary to fill vacancies or for other propositions (often related to taxation or debt issuance). Because the Town is not divided into districts, the Mayor and each Alderman is elected at large (serving the entire community) by plurality vote for staggered two-year terms. "Plurality" simply means that the candidate receiving the most votes is considered elected. In elections decided, instead, by a majority vote, a single candidate must receive more than half of all votes cast.</p>

Have resided in the city for at least six months preceding election day; 3.) Be a registered voter; 4.) Be 18 years of age or older upon the commencement of the term to be filled at the election; 5.) Not have been convicted of a felony for which he or she has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities; and 6.) Not have been deemed mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court.</p> <p>2. Qualifications for the office of Alderman: Be a United States Citizen; 1.)Have been a resident of Texas for at least 12 months as of the deadline for filing for the office; 2.) Have resided in the city for at least six months preceding election day; 3.) Be a registered voter; 4.) Be 18 years of age or older upon the commencement of the term to be filled at the election; 5.)
