
We need more neighbours to participate on the AWRA executive team... please consider volunteering to help us make decisions and get action on neighbourhood issues.

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3/ ACTION PENDING: DEVELOPMENTS, DEVELOPMENTS



2021 has seen an overwhelming pressure and demand placed on AWRA and also other Ward 1 Ratepayers groups! We few volunteers are forced to focus 98% of our efforts on politicking the issues surrounding the following inappropriate massive developments proposed for our area...

- Liberty Developments the Shouldice Hospital property
- Timbercreek Developments Thornhill Square property
- Tridel Developments on Royal Orchard and Bayview
- Langstaff Gateway Developments on Langstaff between Yonge & Bayview

We won't elaborate on the status quo for those developments in this newsletter, as there are many... come to the Annual General Meeting on Nov. 18 at 7:00pm for a more in-depth update... REGISTER in ADVANCE please.

Because these projects will have overlapping **severe** impacts on the unarguable traffic congestion, overuse of the Thornhill Community Centre, the loss of green space, etc., etc., we've been studying the development applications, making deputations, attending lots of meetings, and communicating with city staff and Councilors to get the following...

- Markham needs to pass an interim control bylaw to halt further planning work on these developments for up to 12 months, while...
- Markham needs to create a Thornhill Village Sub-Committee with all major stakeholders represented, including the impacted ratepayers' groups, developers, planners, etc., who will...
- **Help create a new Thornhill Secondary Plan**, replacing the one created in 1987 (partly revised in 1995)... to better reflect the realities of Ward 1.

Come to the Annual Meeting to let your voices be heard by our Ward 1 Councilor Keith Irish and other Councilors that may be in attendance.

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4/ DELAYED: MAPLE VALLEY TRAIL SYSTEM ACCESS

The formal Maple Valley access point has been delayed pending the rebuild of the Huntington Trail ramp over the culvert system for the German Mills Creek north of Evergreen Cres. With a \$1 million price tag, the ramp repair won't occur 'till the 2022 timeframe.



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7/ MOSTLY DONE: SPEED HUMP RE-CONDITIONING on Willowbrook




 The humps have been replaced. There is still one hump near Henricks on Willowbrook which is still a bit too high... we are working with the City to get that adjusted.

With the traffic congestion on Bayview increasing, so is the use of Willowbrook as a short cut/ bypass to John St... and *the speed humps are there to deter the speed of non-residents* as well as residents.

Aside from the locals who are slowing down for the humps, there are still others who are taking the humps at high speed... and the gouges in the asphalt near the hump show how the offending cars are being thumped for their excess speed.
