Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Christ is Risen!” Even though we have to practice “social distancing” we are always spiritually close as members of the one Body of Christ. Baptism makes us a family in faith, and at Easter we joyfully proclaim the glorious news that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead. In the midst of the Coronavirus Pandemic, Easter this year may be unlike any other, but the light of the resurrection remains undimmed, the cause of our joy undiminished, and the strength of our faith unbroken.

The world turns on the fundamental Easter truth that changes everything and that explains who we are and where we are headed: “Christ, yesterday, today and forever!” On Easter Sunday the Church exults in the joyful proclamation that He is truly risen from the dead. Let us draw closer to one another in our love for Him, and rediscover the things that truly matter in our lives.

Along with you I look forward to the day when we can once again celebrate the Holy Eucharist and the other sacraments together. In the meantime, please be assured of my prayers with you and for you, especially for all those suffering grievously as a result of the pandemic. May the Risen Lord deliver us from all evil and bestow on us the peace and joy that only he can give.

El bautismo nos hace una familia en la fe, y en Pascua proclamamos alegremente la gloriosa noticia de que Jesucristo ha resucitado de la muerte. En el medio de la pandemia de coronavirus, la Pascua de este año puede ser diferente a cualquier otra, pero a la luz de la resurrección permanece intacta, la causa de nuestro gozo no disminuida y la fuerza de nuestra fe intacto.

Como nos dijo: "Nadie viene al Padre excepto a través de mí."

Nuestra misión es siempre hacer que el Evangelio sea creíble para los demás amando a Dios sobre todas las cosas y nuestro vecino como nosotros mismos. Ahora es el momento de intensificar nuestras oraciones y sacrificios por el amor de Dios y el amor de nuestro prójimo. Acerquémonos unos a otros en nuestro amor por Él, y redescubrir las cosas que realmente importan en nuestras vidas.

Junto con ustedes espero con ansias el día en que podamos celebrar una vez más el Santo Eucaristía y los demás sacramentos juntos. Mientras tanto, tenga la seguridad de mis oraciones con usted y para usted, especialmente para todos aquellos que sufren gravemente como resultado de la pandemia. Puede el El Señor resucitado nos libra de todo mal y nos otorga la paz y la alegría que solo él puede dar.

Dear brothers in the Risen Lord:

As we celebrate this Easter of resurrection, in the midst of the coronavirus pandemic, the Lord calls us not to fear, he is our hope, our strength.
