EVERDAY STEWARDSHIP-RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Recognizing the Voice of Jesus

When my wireless provider introduced HD Voice, the voice I heard on my phone was unbelievably clear, and it felt at times like both the caller and I were in the same room. The best aspect of this feature is that it didn't cost the customer any additional fees, and it didn't require any changes to the phone. I could say it was free, but I suspect I was already paying for it in my monthly bill anyway. At least it felt free.

The clearer the voice calling you, the easier it is to recognize who it is on the other end of the line. In John's Gospel, Jesus speaks of the gatekeeper who opens the gate and calls for his sheep. They respond because they know his voice. Others try to lure the sheep when the gatekeeper is not there, but the sheep find their voices unclear or unfamiliar.

Jesus is our gatekeeper. But unlike receiving something for free from a wireless company, to be able to hear his voice we need to pay attention and practice listening. By developing a stewardship way of life that is mindful and prayerful, we become attuned to his voice and are able to discern when the call is from our Lord and when it is from an imposter. It is great to talk about all the things we can do and all the gifts we can share, but if we are not listening for his call to hear where our offerings are needed, we can end up like a lost sheep searching for the gatekeeper.

JORNADA MUNDIAL DE ORACIÓN POR LAS VOCACIONES



El objetivo de la Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones es cumplir públicamente la instrucción del Señor de: "Rogad al Dueño de la mies que envíe obreros a su mies" (Mt 9,38; Lc 10,2). Como colofón a una oración que se ofrece continuamente en toda la Iglesia, afirma la primacía de la fe y de la gracia en todo lo que se refiere a las vocaciones al sacerdocio ya la vida consagrada. Apreciando todas las vocaciones, la Iglesia concentra su atención este día en las vocaciones a los ministerios ordenados (sacerdocio y diaconado), la vida consagrada en todas sus formas (vida religiosa masculina y femenina, sociedades de vida apostólica, virginidad consagrada), los institutos seculares en su diversidad de servicios y membresía, y a la vida misionera.

LA HISTORIA DE SAN JOSÉ EL OBRERO DÍA DE FIESTA - 1RO DE MAYO

¿Quieres aprender a ser un perfecto trabajador y proveedor en las cosas físicas y espirituales? Mire a San José a partir del 1 de mayo.

El 1 de mayo fue la celebración del "Primero de Mayo" por parte de los comunistas. Para contrarrestar esta celebración secular de lo que significaba para ellos el trabajo, en 1955 el Siervo de Dios Papa Pío XII instituyó esta fiesta de San José Obrero. También tenía otro propósito principal: aumentar la devoción al santo que era el modelo de los trabajadores, proveyendo para su esposa María y su hijo adoptivo Jesús. También recordó la dignidad del trabajo.

En 2005 el Papa Emérito Benedicto XVI señaló: "Es necesario vivir una espiritualidad que ayude a los creyentes a santificarse a través de su trabajo, imitando a San José, que tuvo que proveer con sus propias manos a las necesidades diarias de la Sagrada Familia y que, en consecuencia, la Iglesia se erige como Patrona de los trabajadores".

Luego San Juan Pablo II se centró en San José en Redemptoris Custos (Guardián del Redentor). Nos enseñó: "Si la Familia de Nazaret es ejemplo y modelo para las familias humanas, en el orden de la salvación y de la santidad, también lo es, por analogía, la obra de Jesús al lado de José el carpintero. En nuestros días, la Iglesia ha enfatizado esto al instituir la memoria litúrgica de San José Obrero el 1 de mayo".

THE STORY OF SAINT JOSEPH THE WORKER

To foster deep devotion to Saint Joseph among Catholics, and in response to the “May Day” celebrations for workers sponsored by Communists, Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of Saint Joseph the Worker in 1955. This feast extends the long relationship between Joseph and the cause of workers in both Catholic faith and devotion. Beginning in the Book of Genesis, the dignity of human work has long been celebrated as a participation in the creative work of God. By work, humankind both fulfills the command found in Genesis to care for the earth (Gn 2:15) and to be productive in their labors. Saint Joseph, the carpenter and foster father of Jesus, is but one example of the holiness of human labor.



Jesus, too, was a carpenter. He learned the trade from Saint Joseph and spent his early adult years working side-by-side in Joseph’s carpentry shop before leaving to pursue his ministry as preacher and healer. In his encyclical *Laborem Exercens*, Pope John Paul II stated: “the Church considers it her task always to call attention to the dignity and rights of those who work, to condemn situations in which that dignity and those rights are violated, and to help to guide [social] changes so as to ensure authentic progress by man and society.”

Saint Joseph is held up as a model of such work. Pius XII emphasized this when he said, “The spirit flows to you and to all men from the heart of the God-man, Savior of the world, but certainly, no worker was ever more completely and profoundly penetrated by it than the foster father of Jesus, who lived with Him in closest intimacy and community of family life and work.”
