*"Why might a non-Catholic consider or need an annulment?"*

*"Does a divorced person need an annulment when the marriage was performed only by a Justice of the Peace?"*

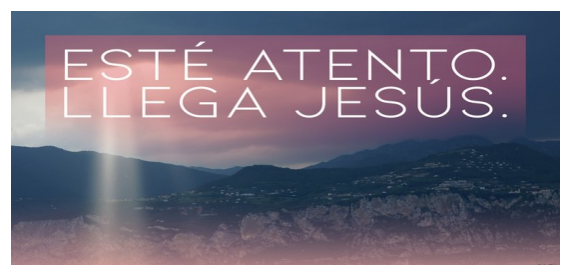
