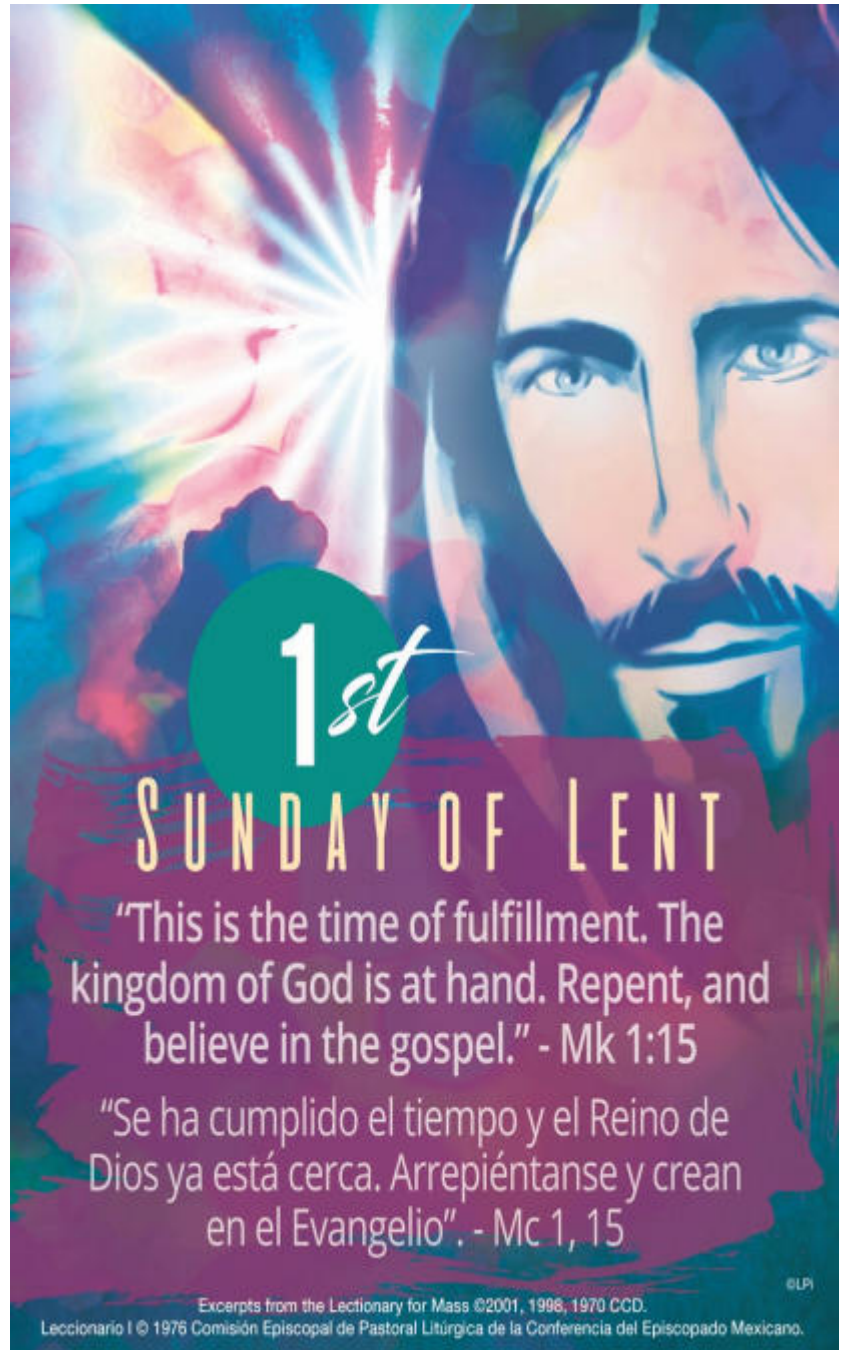

LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Fasting is on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for those 18-59 years of age.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. Abstinence is every Friday during Lent for those 14 years of age and older.

NORMAS DE AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia para los católicos. Además, los viernes de Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia.

Para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Romana, las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 hasta los 59 años. Al ayunar, una persona puede comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no equivalen a una comida completa. Las normas relativas a la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Romana desde los 14 años en adelante.

Con el fin de ser padrino o madrina para el Bautismo o Confirmación se requiere las siguientes normas:

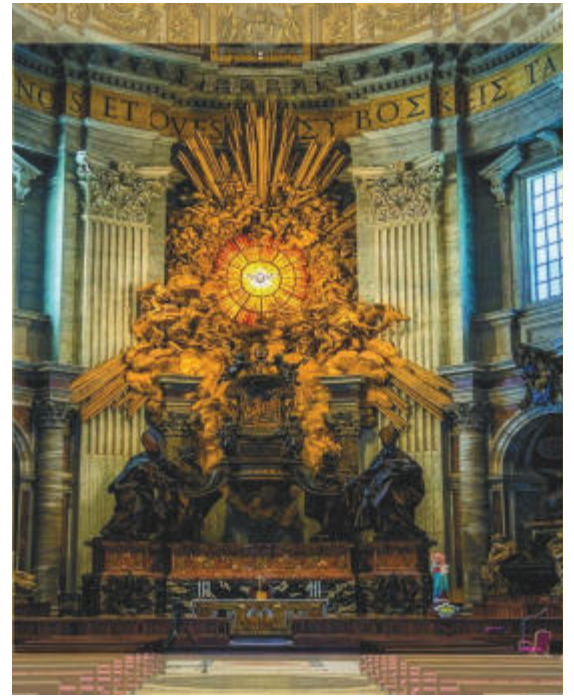
- Ser registrado en la parroquia

THE FEAST OF THE CHAIR OF ST. PETER
FEBRUARY 22

A feast for a chair? It might seem surprising, but every year on February 22nd we celebrate the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter. The Latin word for "chair" is cathedra. From there we get the word "cathedral" to designate literally the "seat" of the bishop. Cathedrals - and the bishop's chairs inside - are symbols of the bishop's authority.

So on this feast we don't celebrate where the Apostle Peter sat down, but we celebrate the Church and her apostolic origin. As Pope Benedict XVIII said, "it is a symbol of the special mission of Peter and his Successors to tend Christ's flock, keeping it united in faith and in charity" (Angelus Message, February 19, 2012).

The wooden throne encased in bronze by the greatest sculptor of the 17th century, Gian Lorenzo Bernini was given to Pope John VIII by the Holy Roman Emperor Charles the Bald in 875. It is located in Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome.



FIESTA DE LA CÁTEDRA DE SAN PEDRO - 22 DE FEBRERO

¿Un festín para una silla? Puede parecer sorprendente, pero todos los años el 22 de febrero celebramos la Fiesta de la Cátedra de San Pedro. La palabra latina para "silla" es cátedra. De ahí obtenemos la palabra "catedral" para designar literalmente la "sede" del obispo. Las catedrales, y las sillas del obispo en el interior, son símbolos de la autoridad del obispo.

Entonces en esta fiesta no celebramos donde se sentó el Apóstol Pedro, sino que celebramos la Iglesia y su origen apostólico. Como dijo el Papa Benedicto XVIII, "es un símbolo de la misión especial de Pedro y sus Sucesores de cuidar el rebaño de Cristo, manteniéndolo unido en la fe y en la caridad" (Mensaje del Ángelus, 19 de febrero de 2012).

El trono de madera revestido en bronce por el gran escultor del siglo XVII, Gian Lorenzo Bernini, fue entregado al Papa Juan VIII por el emperador Carlos el Calvo en 875. Está ubicado en la Basílica de San Pedro en Roma.

Pope Francis proclaims "Year of St Joseph"

With the Apostolic Letter "Patris corde" ("With a Father's Heart"), Pope Francis recalls the 150th anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a "Year of Saint Joseph" from today, 8 December 2020, to 8 December 2021.

Prayer to St Joseph, which Pope Francis encourages all of us to pray together:

*Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
To you God entrusted his only Son;
in you Mary placed her trust;
with you Christ became man.
Blessed Joseph, to us too,
show yourself a father
and guide us in the path of life.
Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage,
and defend us from every evil. Amen.*
