EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Planted in the House of the Lord

Grocery delivery apps are all the rage these days, and I can't deny the convenience of tapping your finger a few times and seeing your week's shopping dropped on the doorstep. But there is one aspect of this trend that seems to make a lot of shoppers nervous — fruits and vegetables.

A lot of us have strong opinions on our fresh produce and aren't ready to delegate this highly subjective selection process to a total stranger. My father was a produce manager and I remember as a child learning about the complexities of choosing correctly. Getting a bad bag of under ripe tomatoes after shopping on an app could easily sour one on the whole idea.

Forrest Gump said life is like a box of chocolates. I say, we're all like grab-bags of produce dumped on someone's doorstep — but if we're Christians who live our faith publicly, we're stamped with the name of God. If your thumb is green enough, you know that you can tell a lot about a gardener from the produce he grows. We who are planted in the house of the Lord — what do we reveal about our Gardener?

What do our actions show of His teachings? What do our words reflect of His voice? What does our strength reveal of the soil from which we sprang and the life-giving waters that nourished us?

When we open ourselves up to those we encounter, let's make a special effort to show the care we have had — lest our peers come away from the experience thinking God doesn't know how to garden, when in reality, it's us who don't always know how to grow.

Lent FAQs

I understand that Catholics ages 18 to 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, but what exactly are the rules for these fasts?

Fasting on these days means we can have only one full, meatless meal. Some food can be taken at the other regular meal times if necessary *but combined they should be less than a full meal*. Liquids are allowed at any time, but no solid food should be consumed between meals.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

8º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Antes de llegar al Miércoles de Ceniza e iniciar la Cuaresma, continuamos escuchando este domingo una serie de imágenes para enseñarnos lo que es la coherencia entre la fe y la vida. Si recordamos bien, el domingo pasado, el Señor dejó claro las reglas para una vida cristiana más justa y humana. Eso de amar a los enemigos y hacer el bien, no todos lo comprendemos y llevamos a cabo.

Ahora, Jesús usa esta comparación con la siguiente pregunta. "Puede un ciego guiar a otro ciego? Ciertamente caerán ambos en algún hoyo" (Lucas 6,39). Un ciego mal acompañado de seguro tropezará y caerá al precipicio. Estas parábolas llenas de sabiduría son el corazón del Evangelio. ¿Cómo comprender esta parábola? ¿Cómo ponerla en práctica? La siguiente enseñanza es lo referente a la paja en el ojo ajeno. Se refiere a evitar las malas intenciones o la crítica a los demás. Dejar de hablar de los demás es un proceso de toda la vida. La corrección fraterna en la familia y en la sociedad lleva mucho de la educación cristiana y civil. Es decir, que, si se aplican las enseñanzas del Evangelio, se darán frutos buenos; y si no se aplican, el fruto es lo contrario. "Así, el hombre bueno saca cosas buenas del tesoro que tiene en su corazón, mientras que el malo, de su fondo malo saca cosas malas. La boca habla de lo que está lleno su corazón" (Lucas 6,45). Solo queda escuchar la Palabra de Dios y aplicarla en la vida, porque como se expresa la persona, da a conocer quién es.

“Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return.”

This phrase comes from God’s response to Adam (Genesis 3:19). God reminds Adam of the effects of sin and of humanity’s dependence on God. Read Genesis 2:4–9, and explain that the breath of God sustains all living things. Adam and Eve turned away from God when they ate from the tree of knowledge. When we mark our foreheads with ashes at the beginning of Lent, we are indicating that we are turning back to God.

“Acuérdate que eres polvo y al polvo volverás”.

LENTEN READING

Question:

Can you recommend some good books for Lenten spiritual reading?

Answer:

On more than one occasion, a coach being interviewed about his team--successful or not--will be asked about the next step. The inevitable response includes something about getting back to basics. Reviewing the fundamentals of the sport strengthens performance and builds confidence.

The best Lenten reading takes us back to the fundamentals. If Lent is the time for the Church to be on retreat, then we should focus on the texts that help us deepen our understanding of our faith. Spend time reading one of the Gospels, and use a Scripture commentary to learn all you can about the passion of Jesus. Read about the lives of the saints, especially your patron saint and that of your parish. Perhaps there is some local candidate for sainthood, like Father Walter Cizek, SJ, who wrote several faith-inspiring books. Finally, you can use the Catechism of the Catholic Church to learn more about the church's teachings and beliefs. The sections on prayer and the Mass are really great reflections. Focusing on the basics really helps us take another step forward in our faith. We have not only a better understanding of what we believe and practice, but also why we believe. With that belief comes the confidence we need to be better, more faithful witnesses to Christ.
