Probablemente esté soñando despierto con el fin de semana anual de escapadas en cabañas o con el esquí acuático el 4 de julio.

En general, el verano va a ser un buen descanso, incluso si, como los estadounidenses típicos, nuestro descanso está lleno de trabajo productivo.

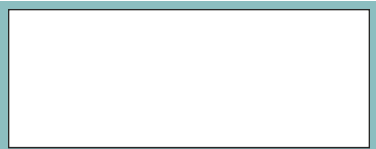

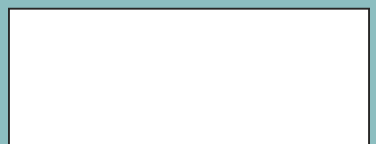

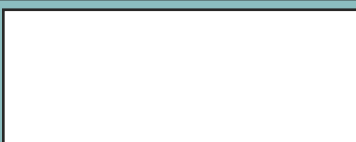
