Question:

What is spiritual communion, and do you need to be in a state of grace to receive it?



Answer:

The practice of making a “spiritual communion” dates back several centuries and St. Thomas Aquinas described it as “an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy Sacrament and a loving embrace as though we had already received Him.” Traditionally, a prayer of spiritual communion has been used by those who are unable to receive sacramental communion because of health, inability to attend Mass, or who cannot receive communion because of grave sin. This practice has been encouraged by many saints and spiritual writers and most recently Pope Francis encouraged the practice when the realities of the COVID-19 pandemic prevented so many Catholics from taking part in the Mass or receiving sacramental communion.

Although the graces offered in spiritual communion are not the same as those offered in the sacramental communion of the Mass, this practice is still a powerful opportunity to express our desire for union with the Lord and to be united with Christ and the Church, even in an imperfect way.

Pregunta:

¿Qué es la comunión espiritual y necesitas estar en estado de gracia para recibirla?



Respuesta:

La práctica de hacer una “comunión espiritual” se remonta a varios siglos y Santo Tomás de Aquino la describió como “un deseo ardiente de recibir a Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento y un abrazo amoroso como si ya lo hubiéramos recibido”. Tradicionalmente, quienes no pueden recibir la comunión sacramental debido a su salud, no pueden asistir a misa o no pueden recibir la comunión debido a un pecado grave, han utilizado tradicionalmente una oración de comunión espiritual. Esta práctica ha sido alentada por muchos santos y escritores espirituales y, más recientemente, el Papa Francisco alentó la práctica cuando las realidades de la pandemia COVID-19 impidieron que muchos católicos participaran en la Misa o recibieran la comunión sacramental.

Aunque las gracias ofrecidas en la comunión espiritual no son las mismas que las ofrecidas en la comunión sacramental de la Misa, esta práctica sigue siendo una poderosa oportunidad para expresar nuestro deseo de unión con el Señor y de estar unidos con Cristo y la Iglesia, incluso en una forma imperfecta.

POR FAVOR TOME NOTA...

A partir del 2 de abril la misa del viernes a las 9:00 a.m. en el Santuario de Santa Ana será eliminada del horario.

Desde el 1 de abril hasta el 6 de mayo la misa del jueves a las 6:30 p.m. será cancelada temporalmente. El horario de misa los jueves se reanudará el 13 de mayo a la misma hora.

Los viernes de Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia. El Viernes Santo es día de ayuno y abstinencia.

Para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Romana, las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 hasta los 59 años. Al ayunar, una persona puede comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no equivalen a una comida completa. Las normas relativas a la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Romana desde los 14 años en adelante.
