A REFLECTION ON TODAY'S GOSPEL BY FR. DIEGO JIMENEZ

The readings this weekend bring us closer to the end of the liturgical year, but also put us ahead of the faith and fidelity to the Lord. In his discourse, Jesus speaks of two ends. It is somewhat confusing, difficult to understand from the human viewpoint, and maybe even to your own eyes. One is the end of human history as such; the other is the end of the order which until then had governed the Jewish people, that is, the order of which had a more visible presence of the temple of Jerusalem.

When he said that he would not pass the generation without fulfilling "everything" it is meant in part to be about himself, for his life on earth was nearing its end, and indeed in his death some of the signs that he describes were met, but he was referring in part to the end of Jerusalem, as shown undoubtedly in other apocalyptic texts in his speeches.

The important thing for us, leaving the details to biblical scholars, is that the Lord invites us to look at the signs of the times and to recognize that the ultimate victory is preceded by all kinds of events and situations that touch all aspects and levels of our life, our world and our history.

Faith, then, is much more than one of many methods to behave in society and be able to coexist with others. Believing is not only being a good person; it is to understand and proclaim that there is one who is Lord and that his lordship is all encompassing as his science and as his mercy.

This same faith must lead us to practice charity to the sufferer, who is our neighbor. Being merciful is not to miss the Word of God, which strengthens our heart. Let that same light of the Lord, radiate today in our being and bring us closer to his love.

UNA REFLEXIÓN SOBRE EL EVANGELIO

Las lecturas este fin de semana nos van acercando al final del año litúrgico, pero también nos ponen de cara a la fe y fidelidad al Señor. Jesús en su discurso habla de dos finales, es algo confuso, difícil de comprender desde la mirada humana, y quizá incluso en su propia mirada. Uno es el final de la Historia humana en cuanto tal; otro es el final del orden que hasta entonces regía para el pueblo judío, o sea, el orden que tenía como presencia más visible, el templo de Jerusalén.

Cuando él dijo que no pasaría esa generación sin que "todo" se cumpliera se refería en parte a sí mismo, pues su vida sobre esta tierra tocaba a su final, y de hecho en su muerte se cumplieron algunos de los signos que él describe, pero se refería en parte también al final de Jerusalén, como lo muestran, sin duda, otros textos de tono apocalíptico en discursos suyos.

Lo importante para nosotros, dejando los detalles a los estudiosos de la Biblia, es que el Señor nos invita a mirar los signos de los tiempos y a reconocer que la victoria definitiva va precedida por toda clase de eventos y situaciones que tocan todos los aspectos y niveles de nuestra vida, de nuestro mundo y de nuestra historia.

La fe, entonces, es mucho más que uno entre tantos métodos para portarse bien en la sociedad y ser capaz de convivir con otros. Creer no es sólo ser buena persona; es comprender y proclamar que hay uno que es Señor, y que su señorío lo abarca todo, como su ciencia y como su misericordia.

Esta misma fe nos tiene que llevar a practicar la caridad con el que sufre, el que está a nuestro lado. Ser misericordiosos, es no dejar pasar la Palabra de Dios, ella hace fuerza en nuestro corazón. Dejemos que esa misma luz del Señor, irradie hoy nuestro ser y nos una más a su amor.

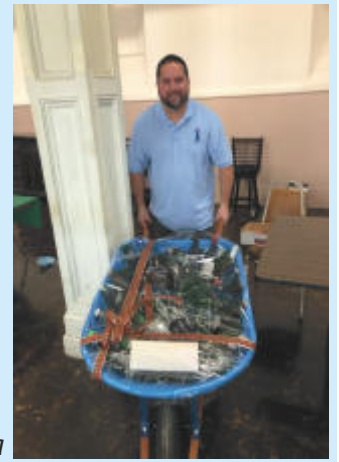

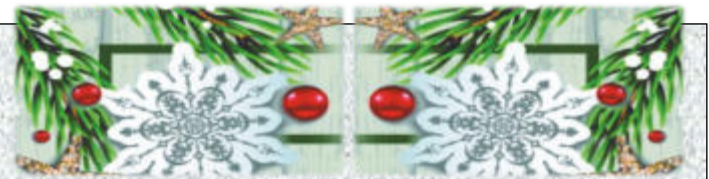

All are welcome to attend!! It is sure to be a enjoyable and informative hour! There is no fee to attend, however, free will donations will be accepted and appreciated.

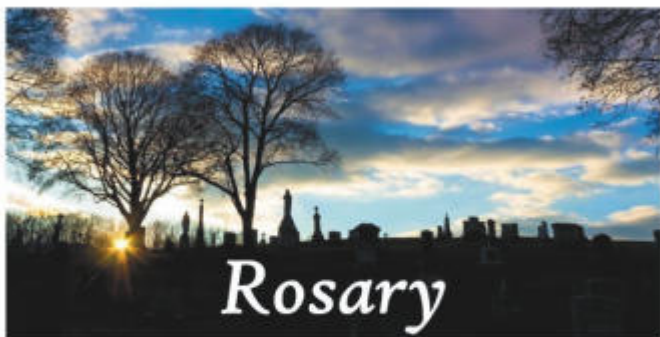
