## The Sandwich Project

The Sandwich Project began in 1986 at Blessed Sacrament Church and has operated continuously ever since. Sandwiches are made by four teams on alternate weeks, coordinated by team captains, and delivered to the Homeless Shelter. Dozens of volunteers have participated during its 30-plus year history.

Currently, the project is staffed in excess of 50 volunteers coming primarily from Blessed Sacrament Church and from All Saints-Todos los Santos Parish (Shrine of St. Anne and Church of Our Lady of Lourdes).

Carolyn Platt is the Team Captain for All Saints-Todos los Santo Parish and Emma Barone is the lead person at Our Lady of Lourdes Church.
