The Piecemaker 's Sewing Group is a group of volunteers from St. John's church, Glandorf. Since 2015 several times throughout the year the ladies get together to make feminine hygiene kits for women and young girls in Haiti and Africa. They also make cloth diapers out of T-shirt fabric as well as cotton dresses. One member spent her Lent making 40 dresses to represent the 40 days of Lent. To date we have made 484 hygiene kits, 604 cloth diapers, and 172 cotton dresses. We accept donations of darker printed cotton fabric as well as darker flannel fabric. We are grateful to the CLC fraternal society for its donation in helping to defray the cost of additional items needed to complete the kits. Many volunteers are members of Council #179, Glandorf.

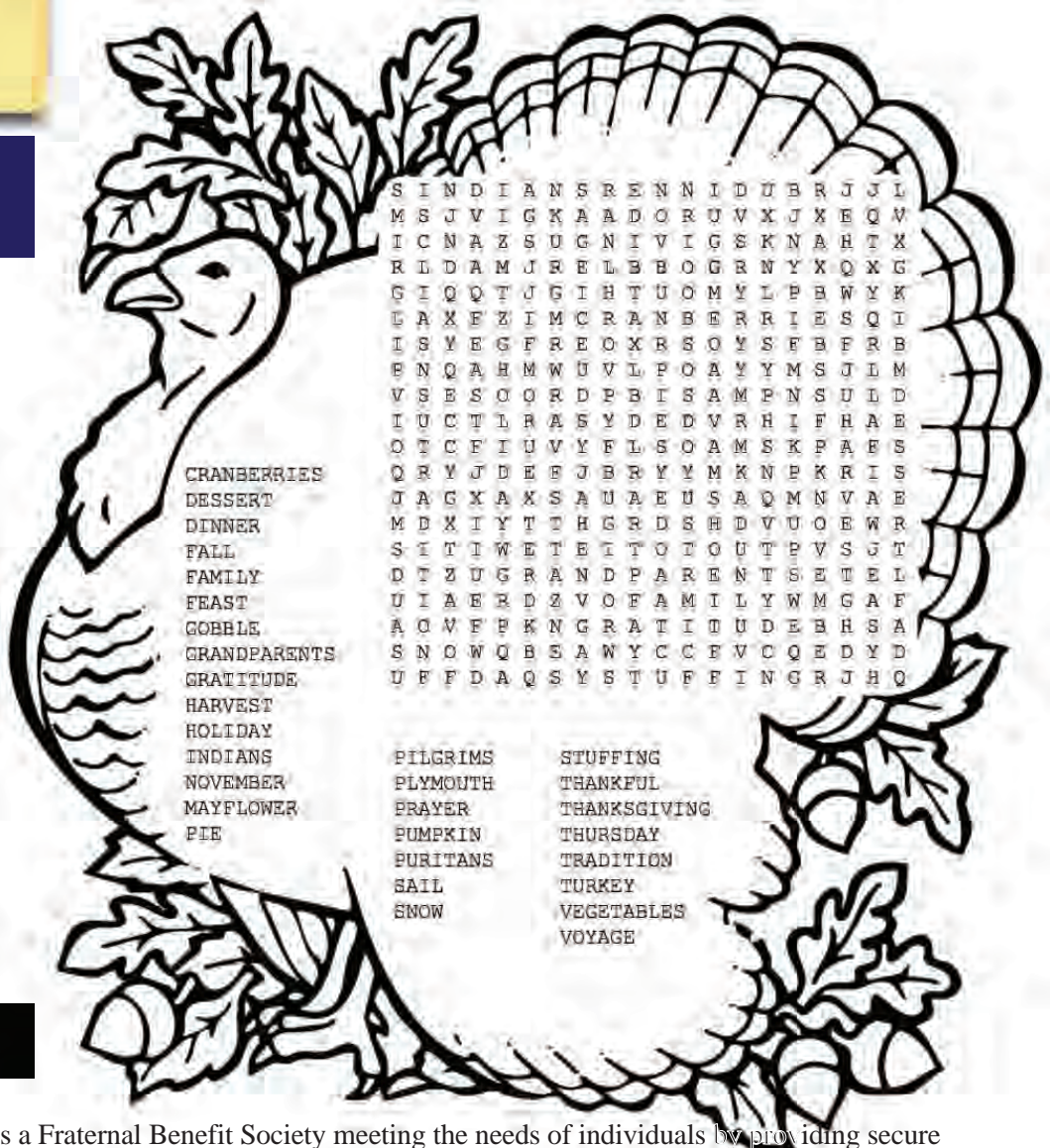
