### CLC's "Make A Difference Day" Charity

The Clinton County Homeless Shelter located in  
Wilmington, Ohio was the first emergency shelter to open  
in a rural Ohio community in 1988.

The shelter maintains four different properties: Women and  
Children's Shelter, AKA Matka Family House; Men's  
Shelter, (the Annex); The Darleen Myers House (the office)  
and their Donation Center.

Today the Clinton County Homeless Shelter can provide  
emergency shelter for up to 38 men, women and children  
each night. It provides approximately 150 meals and snacks  
a day for those who call the shelter home. The Shelter also  
offers assistance for anyone in need of food, clothing and  
household items. Funding for the Shelter includes and  
depends upon donations from fundraisers, individuals,  
churches and businesses.
