Purpose: The Philly Baird Is The Change Scholarship Program was established in 2023. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals enrolled for undergraduate study in community colleges, colleges, trade schools and universities.

Scholarship Awards: Philly Baird Is The Change awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, and Personal Essay. Philly Baird Is The Change pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships are awarded on a one-time basis per recipient. Philly Baird Is The Change Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, faith, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

Award Components: Scholarship awards will be \$500 as determined by the Philly Baird Is The Change Foundation Selection Committee and subject to multiple awards and increase in values.

Criteria:

- Must be a current student of Lathrop High School
- Must be equivalent to a senior in high school
- Must have applied to an undergraduate program at a community college, trade school or university.
- **Must demonstrate leadership qualities as evidenced by involvement in extra-curricular activities**
- Must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or higher
- **Community service is preferred. Provide letter verifying your community service.**

Timeline:

- Completed applications must be emailed no later than March 15, 2024 11:59 PM PST or postmarked by 3/15/2024. We recommend emailing your application.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship at the Scholarship Banquet held at high school.

Scholarship Applicants Must Provide:

- Completed application form
- Copy high school transcript
- Resume highlighting your academic honors, awards and membership activities, community service activities, hobbies, outside interests, extracurricular activities and/or employment experience while in high school achievements, awards, membership, activities and community involvement/service
- One letter of reference confirming in detail how you have made a difference in your community during high school
- Confirmation in writing regarding your choice of community service and hours for those that have serviced their community
- Personal Essay

Scholarship Awards:

- Award notification will be given to Counseling Department.
- Scholarship recipients must provide their **student ID number, proof of acceptance and the mailing address for the Financial Aid Office of the educational institution they will be attending, and approval for use on social media/website.**

Deadline for the application is **March 15, 2024 11:59 PM PST**. Applications postmarked or emailed after this date will not be considered.
