Thank you for participating in the 8th annual Forgotten Youth Ministries *Steps to Freedom Family Fun 5K Run/Walk*. Forgotten Youth Ministries (FYM) fulfills the above mission statement by sharing the love of Jesus in the Saginaw County Juvenile Detention Center and the Bay County Juvenile Home. Your participation in *Steps to Freedom* will help us help the kids in detention. This is how it works . . .

1. Register by completing a registration form in person, at forgottenyouthministries.org, or you may print out and mail in a registration form. Registration is \$15 per family or individual and includes one Steps to Freedom T Shirt, provided your registration is received at least 10 days prior to the event. Additional shirts can also be purchased for \$15 each but **all shirts must be ordered at least 10 days prior to event.**

2. Gather sponsors. You can get a sponsoring envelope from Julie Paul, or go online and print out sponsoring sheets to keep track of the people who are sponsoring you and the funds you raise. **A great way to ask people to sponsor you is to say, "I'm walking in the Forgotten Youth Ministries Steps to Freedom 5K and I wondered if you would like to sponsor me?"** You may also make a personal donation in lieu of collecting pledges.

Either way, for every \$100 you raise, you will receive a ticket for the drawings for \$25 Gift Cards to be given away the day of the 5K. \$100 raised = 1 ticket, \$200 raised = 2 tickets, etc. On the day of the 5K, put the funds you have raised and sponsoring sheets in an envelope or, if you registered in person, use the envelope provided.

3. Come run or walk. Bring your sponsoring sheet(s)/envelope with your sponsorship funds to the Saginaw Township Soccer Complex. **Check in starts at 8:30 a.m. Run/walk starts at 9:00, and prizes and silent auction items will be awarded at 10:30 at the pavilion.**

It's that easy! This is a fun, healthy way to help FYM continue to reach out to detained youth. Thank you and may God bless you for helping Forgotten Youth Ministries reach the kids in detention with the love of Jesus!
