Welcome Spring! The season of all that is new, including the Garden Manager here at Elawa Farm! I am delighted to be here. To those I still have yet to meet, allow me to introduce myself. My name is Regina Cady, I reside just down the road in Vernon Hills where I have lived with my husband and two step-sons for the past six years. There, I worked for the Vernon Hills Park District as Horticulturist, a very enjoyable time, but one that left me with a yearning to be back in the soil more and interacting more deeply with people, teaching and showing all that the Good Earth has to offer.



I have a unique background that will enable me to provide many opportunities to the area residents and visitors to closely interact with the many programs here at Elawa. 
