We visited in several homes, prayed over many, many people, did two baby dedications, spoke to a group of 40 or so widows and widowers. Never a dull moment with a group of Texans, and one Pennsylvanian on our team. Like "Home on the Range," Never a discouraging word. While we did have one team member

become ill and visit the doctor a few times, it was very hot, and our flight home was caught up in an airlines schedule change since purchasing our tickets, and some of us tested positive for COVID.
