We are up and running for the 9th year of the Backpack Ministry program. We have gone through a lot of changes and learned a lot, but the dedication of the parishioners of the four partnering churches is as strong as ever.

Beginning 10/26/2020, all elementary students were back in school all five days with the exception of the virtual students. We had been delivering the backpacks twice a week when the students were on the hybrid schedule, but now that the students are back in school full time we will go back to delivering once a week. Our goal is to remain flexible as the Covid 19 situation warrants. The school district is publishing a district wide summary of Covid 19 cases by school every Friday.

With some slight modifications, we have been able to use the space at the District 55 Administration Building that we originally had so we are very grateful for that.
