

October 2023 Backpack Ministry Update

We began our distribution without any incidents but now with the new school calendar, we are closed for two weeks while the students are on Fall Break. I have located a source of quart-size shelf stable whole milk for \$1.25 so we will begin using this for all the students who can carry the extra weight in their bags. The youngest students will still receive one 8 oz carton of white milk and one 8 oz carton of chocolate milk. The price of these two 8 oz cartons together is \$2.33 per backpack. The 13 youngest students we are providing weekend food for are in Pre-K. Our ministry is a blessing to these students who do not have sufficient nutrition.
