A MESSAGE FROM FATHER PAUL ABERNATHY

You & My Prayers – A Personal Word

My Beloved Sisters and Brothers,

Each Sunday, I rejoice to hear those words in The Prayers of the People when our Lay Eucharistic Minister prays for the clergy, saying, "For Michael (Curry), our Presiding Bishop, Andrew (Waldo), our Bishop, and for Paul, our priest."

In this life, with all of its joys and difficulties, wonders and worries, I believe that our praying one for another, for the sake of one another is one of our grandest offerings to God. Thus, to know that you pray for me and as your priest matters greatly to me, touches my soul and warms my heart.

So, in the spirit of sharing, please, know this...

Yes, I pray for those persons for whom and those circumstances of which you have asked me to include in my intercessions. Yet I also pray for you by name. Daily, usually first thing upon waking and, sometimes, given the morning's schedule, surely, by noon, I hold our Parish Directory before my eyes and, alphabetically (sometimes, in reverse order) go down (or up!) our listing, reciting each of your names. And though I cannot know all that will transpire in your lives, I ask that God grant you every blessing of wisdom and discernment, strength and patience, joy and delight in the coming hours. And though I do not know all those whose lives you touch and whose lives will touch yours, God knows. Thus, though anonymous to me, I pray for them, too.

And, usually, I close my prayers, thinking of all of us, with For Joy in God's Creation (The Book of Common Prayer, page 814):

O heavenly Father, who hast filled the world with beauty: Open our eyes to behold thy gracious hand in all thy works; that, rejoicing in thy whole creation, we may learn to serve thee with gladness; for the sake of him through whom all things were made, thy Son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
