Spring Crew fees pay for team operational expenses including boat maintenance, gas, insurance, safety equipment, administrative needs, coach stipends and team VASRA membership. Spring Crew fees do not include spirit wear (optional), transportation, or out-of-town regatta travel expenses (for qualifying boats).

Fundraising donations support new or gently used equipment purchases, oar refurbishment, boat shoes, cox boxes, launches, etc.

_____ Fundraising donations/contributions collected by a student will not be refunded.

_____ Per LCPS Student Activities Handbook: "Although participation by students is highly desirable, there are no guarantees that all athletes will participate in all games. Playing time for athletes is the sole decision of the Head Coach and their staff. Coaches are encouraged to give each student the opportunity to participate in as many games as practical."

Student/Athletes will receive:

- Full refund of Spring Crew and uniform fees if the student does not make the team after tryouts on 2/23/2024.
- Full refund of Spring Crew and uniform fees if a student withdraws by end of tryouts on 2/23/2024.
- No refunds will be issued after 2/23/2024 unless there is a LCPS shutdown or the student has a medical issue, as outlined above.
